Purpose of Learning Continuity & Attendance Plan

- Articulates the District's response to the pandemic as well as the use of funding to equitably support all of our students

- Tiered Re-Engagement Plan:
 - Traditional support classes
 - Support periods
 - Assessment Plan:
 - ELA: Reading Inventory for all 9th graders and struggling learners in Language Arts
 - Math: MDTP Assessment for all students in
- In-person Learning Pods:
 - High-need students (EL's, Students with IEP's, students who need connectivity or a place to learn)
