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The Definition of Multi-Prime

With Multi Prime Contracting, the Owner (PUSD) becomes the “General Contractor,” or “Owner/Builder” and controls the Project by bidding and holding separate contracts with contractors (prime contractors) in various construction work disciplines, e.g., earthwork, structural, mechanical, and electrical. **This is carried-out by using an experienced Construction Management firm to be the District’s representative or “agent.”** Using this approach, the construction manager (CM) manages the entire project for the District including the design, contract documents, design and **construction schedules, bidding, onsite project management, procurement, estimating and budgeting.** While this places much accountability and responsibility with the CM, **the District can realize savings by cutting-out markups to one general contractor who, generally, subs out 90 to 100% of the work anyway and adds a markup to those contracts. Savings can also be realized by direct purchasing of materials, performing in-house work not requiring specialized labor,** and focusing all designers, contractors, professionals, etc., to focus on their strengths to promote a more defined scope of work which always lead to better bids and pricing. **A “prime” example of this was the recently completed project at Quincy Elementary.**
