

Build upon and continue the planning for in-person learning.





All Students Matter



1:1 tutoring for 2-5 students with volunteers 2x/week around literacy or math; Classroom Volunteers to assist during teachers' Zoom classes (K-5)

Ravenswood Reads



1:1 Literacy Tutoring for K-3 students with volunteers 2x/wk using a literacy intervention curriculum; initial focus on K/1 with additional support for Spanish tutoring


Internet Needs - Survey Analysis
