






Are your child's needs being met with the instructional program? / ¿Se satisfacen las necesidades de su hijo(a) con el programa de instrucción?




Are your child's needs being met in remote learning?




Please rate your overall experience with distance learning since the start of school:







Parents: Comfort Returning to Hybrid





Parents: LVE Comfort Returning to Hybrid









Certificated Staff Comfort Returning to Hybrid





Classified Staff Comfort Returning to Hybrid





Cases Per Day by Test Date among Marin County Community Residents

This chart shows the daily number of newly reported cases (positive test results) among Marin County community residents (does not include San Quentin inmates) by test date. If an individual was tested on May 20 and Marin HHS received a positive result for that test on May 24, their positive result would be reflected in this chart and the positives and negatives test per day chart below on May 20.



Note: On 8/11/2020 the reference date for this chart was changed from report date to test date. This reflects the earliest date on record for a COVID-19 case. Due to the time required for reporting data is lagged by 3 days. Positive cases may be under-reported for up to 10 days.

Droplet vs. Airborne Precautions

- Droplet vs. Airborne Precautions
 - The epidemiology of SARS-CoV-2 indicates that most infections are spread through close contact, not airborne transmission
 - There is no evidence of efficient spread (i.e., routine, rapid spread) to people far away or who enter a space hours after an infectious person was there.
 - The best way to prevent the spread of Covid-19 is to wear a face covering, maintain physical distance and avoid large indoor gatherings (> 50).

“The primary way that COVID 19 is transmitted is through close contact and droplets.”

- "We have very low rates of COVID 19 amongst children in our county."
- "We are not anticipating that we are going back into the purple tier. We actually anticipate that we are moving into the orange tier."
- "We are preparing for a second wave."
- "Where we see the highest amount of COVID transmission is in households."
- "COVID 19 will enter into our school communities."
- "The first protection is parents...They are the key to keeping schools open."
- "There are very few child to adult transmissions documented. It is much more likely to have a colleague to colleague transmission."
- "The best ventilation is a window."
- "Dr. Willis and I are reevaluating that [air filtration] right now to see if we need to shift any guidance."
-
- "Yes, [it is safe to bring back hybrid classes]. We will continue to monitor the data."
