#### Program Manager

- Developed recruitment outreach strategies that resulted in a 25% increase in student recruitment.

#### Program Manager

- Improved efficiency through management of office staff and 3 mobile clinic teams and systems for providing vision screening and eye exams.
- Designed centralized and efficient distribution of services model resulting in the reduction of lag time and gaps in the delivery of services resulting in 10,000 youth receiving free prescription glasses.
- Successfully established and developed partnerships with CBO's, and Foundations such as Covenant House, Boys & Girls Club of America, The Warriors Foundation, and the Chan Zuckerberg Foundation that helped maintain program funding.
- Increased school partnerships from 14 to 32 in Northern California through development and implementation of a strategic plan for capacity building.
- Effectively modified use of delivery management tools to an increase in the number of low-income students receiving vision screenings by 55% and the number of eye exams provided by 38%.

**Manager School Based Services** (2014-2017)

- Supervised staff of 14 medical personnel while overseeing operations for 3 full service school-based health clinics providing primary and preventative medical, dental, and mental healthcare to students and families.
- Successfully wrote proposals and received grant funding to hire 2 LCSWs and 1 ASW to provide trauma informed care (TIC) based behavioral health services to students.
- Collaborated with school administrators and campus partners such as **R-joy** (Restorative Justice for Oakland Youth) to develop processes and protocols that support trauma informed systems and provide wrap-around support for students experiencing chronic disciplinary actions and suspensions. These programs resulted in fewer suspensions and negative contacts with Principals for students.
- Directed Family Resource Center and After School program that provided behavioral/mental health, reading, literacy, and parent education programs.
- Maintained quality control by conducting regular assessments of all grant funded programs to ensure they met scope of work requirements.
- Managed budgets and developed strategic plans for each SBHC site with a focus on long term sustainability of programs.

**Supervisor Adolescent Services** (2012-2014)

- Supervised staff of 4 medical personnel and managed daily operations of full-service school-based health clinic providing primary and preventative medical, dental and mental healthcare to students and families.
- Developed strategic plan and created administrative systems enabling medical providers to complete over 500 billable visits during the first year of operations.
- Revised, developed, and implemented policies and procedures in the second year of operations resulting in 50% increase in billable visits and revenue.
- Designed and facilitated *WOMS Breathe Easy Asthma Program* providing ongoing asthma management education and clinical care to students diagnosed with asthma.
- Created and managed the *WOMS Wellness Champions Peer Health Educators and Leadership Program* providing students leadership opportunities and roles as peer to peer educators helping classmates make healthy choices in nutrition and behavior.

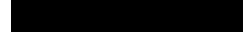
- Utilized data to identify the causes and develop solutions to chronic absenteeism among African-American and LatinX students.
