- ◎ Teacher Toolkit Expansion Installation
 - LVM, Firsher, 1st & 2nd grade are 98% Complete
 - DAV, BHS, LEX 3rd-5th to be completed this week
- ◎ 1-to-1 Teacher "Tech Checks" are underway & are being scheduled
- ◎ LGUSD Tech Tutorial Videos and documentation
- ◎ 1:1, 24/7 Chromebook 3rd-5th Program
 - Scheduled to distribute week of January 18th
- ◎ All school networks have been upgraded and are pending final walkthroughs

Application for School Funding–Due Feb 1

- ◎ Schools may reopen if they submit a COVID-19 Safety Plan to both local SCCOE & Health Dept and state officials
- ◎ Application to include the following
 - Certification that students in distance learning have access to devices and high speed internet
 - Asymptomatic Testing Plan for Staff and Students
 - CALOSHA Covid 19 Emergency Standards Checklist
 - Covid-19 School Guidance Checklist from CDPH
