

Neighborhood Testing Site MOU Between County of San Mateo
and Ravenswood City School District

This document outlines the agreed upon responsibilities of the County of San Mateo (“County”) and Ravenswood City School District (“Local Partner”) in the operation of a Curative COVID-19 testing site. Curative COVID testing is conducted at Bayside Academy.

Collective Goal: Ensure accessible COVID-19 testing to residents to slow the spread of disease and protect community health.

The County will:

- **Identify neighborhood/area for neighborhood testing site.** County Public Health will identify a local area based on current data and information (with as much specificity as the data permit) where Public Health determines that immediate and increased COVID-19 testing is recommended to help contain the spread of disease (“Target Neighborhood”). Public Health will also identify priority demographics such as age and race/ethnicity where data allows.
- **Provide all test kits.** Through its partnership with Curative, the County will provide for all COVID-19 test kits, shipping, lab processing, and result notification associated with a testing event. The County will provide test kits at no cost to the Local Partner or the patient (though the patient’s insurance, if available, may be billed to offset the cost of the test). The COVID-19 test kits are patient administered, and specimen collection does not require clinician monitoring. Curative, Inc., is contractually obligated to the County to deliver test results to patients within 48 hours of receipt of specimen. The County and Curative will determine the maximum number of test kits to be available for a given testing event prior to the date of event.
- **Outreach plan.** County will consult with Curative and Local Partner to identify and implement an effective outreach plan.
- **Testing event/site logistics.** The County and its vendors provide all staff to support the logistics of the testing event.

The Local Partner will:

- **Host the testing site.** The Local Partner will provide a physical location for the testing, including, to the extent possible, parking for staff and residents who seek testing. In addition, Local Partner will provide onsite access to restrooms for staff/volunteers who are operating the testing site. Local Partner will not be accessing any confidential health information pursuant to the MOU.
- **Public outreach.** The Local Partner, in consultation with County, may design and implement targeted public outreach efforts intended to notify residents of the testing event. All outreach materials should be forwarded to the County prior to distribution and must note that the testing event is conducted “in partnership with the County of San Mateo” or similar language.

County and Local Partner further agree as follows:

Local Partner and County shall mutually indemnify and save harmless each other and each other's officers, agents, employees, and servants from all claims, suits, or actions of every name, kind, and description resulting from this MOU, the performance of any work or services required of either party under this MOU, or payments made pursuant to this MOU

The duty of a party to indemnify and save harmless as set forth by this Section shall include the duty to defend as set forth in Section 2778 of the California Civil Code.
