The best practice is to hold the whole event virtually. However, if that is not a practical option, then you should allow only the absolutely depends on the space size. Others should attend remotely. Another example is our County's Board of Supervisor meetings. Half of the Board attends online, and the other half are in the Board chambers: member is also the chambers. Staff reports and public comments are given remotely. About 4-5 people total are in the chambers.

This is a good opportunity to demonstrate the district's ability to operate safely.
