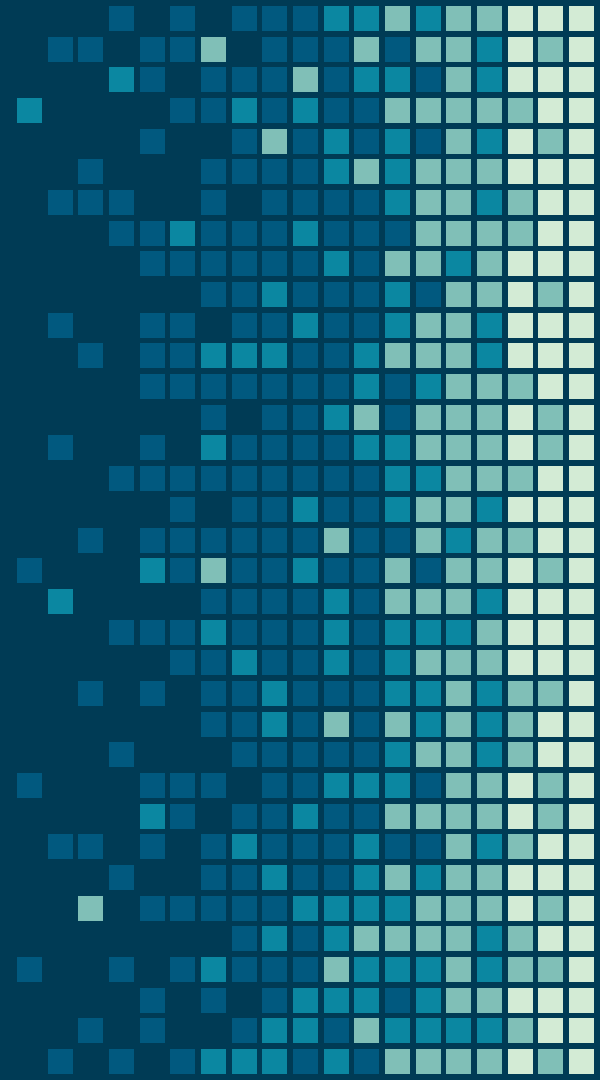


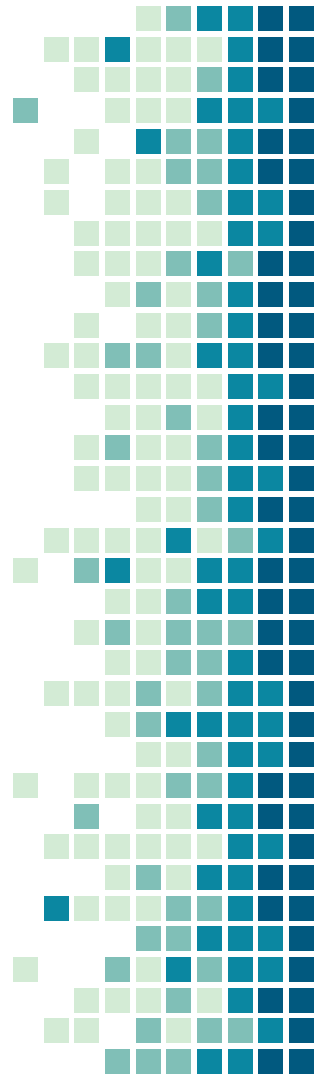

State Guidelines

- Grades TK-6 must have case rate < 25 for five days
- Grade 7-8 must have case rate < 7 for five days
- Re-definition of "open": The school must have given all students in at least one grade the option to return for in-person instruction for at least part of the school week to be considered "open"
- Submit COVID Safety Plan and COVID-19 School Guidance Checklist
- Funding for student testing is subject to State Legislative approval

Testing Cadence

- The State has provided resources (testing supplies, shipment, laboratory capacity, enrollment and reporting technology, training, and assistance with insurance reimbursement)
- State Testing Requirements
 - provide bi-weekly asymptomatic testing of staff
 - response testing to staff and students exposed at school
- State Proposed increased testing cadence including weekly testing staff and students for CR>14 but has not received budget approval at \$450 per student to cover cost.
- LGUSD will continue asymptomatic testing of staff bi-weekly and upon reentry as a “roomer” for all students

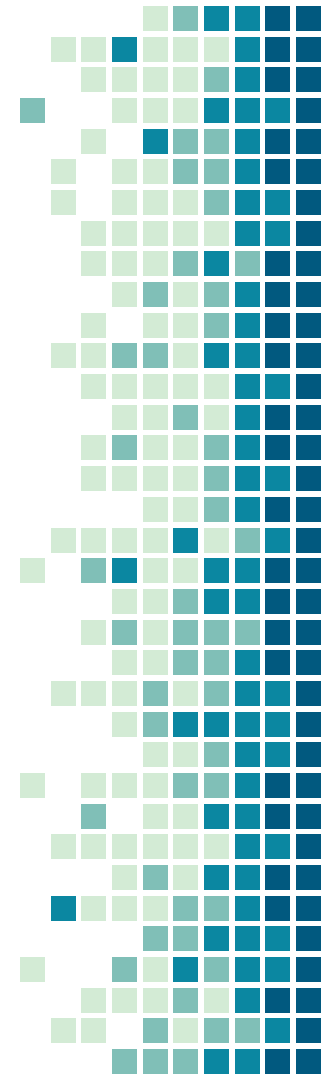

Phase 1B

1B Tier One: WE ARE HERE

About 8.5 million people

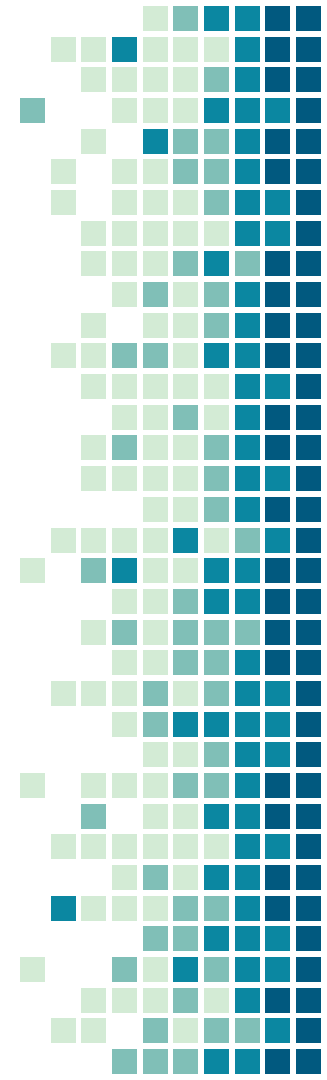
- Individuals 65 and older
- Those at risk of exposure at work in the following sectors:
 - Education and childcare
 - Emergency services
 - Food and agriculture

1B Tier Two:

- Those at risk of exposure at work in the following sectors:
 - Transportation and logistics
 - Industrial, commercial, residential, and sheltering facilities and services
 - Critical manufacturing
- Congregate settings with outbreak risk:
 - Incarcerated
 - Homeless

Phase 1C

- Individuals 50 -64 years of age
- People 16-49 years of age who have an underlying health condition or disability which increases their risk of severe COVID-19
- Those at risk of exposure at work in the following sectors:
 - Water and wastewater
 - Defense
 - Energy
 - Chemical and hazardous materials
 - Communications and IT
 - Financial services
 - Government operations / community-based essential functions

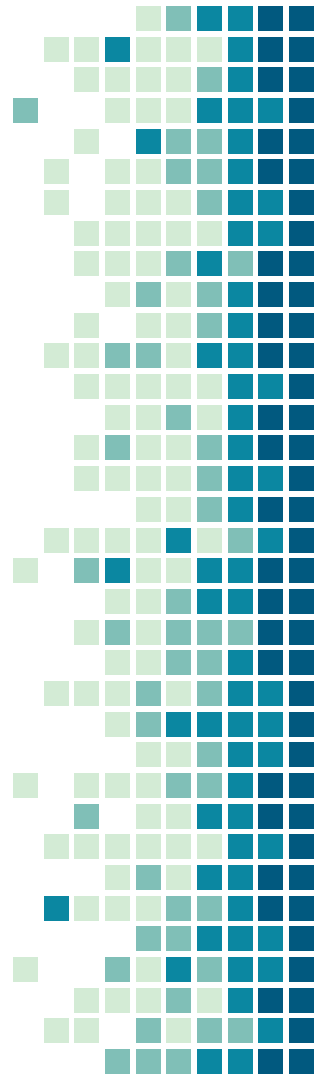

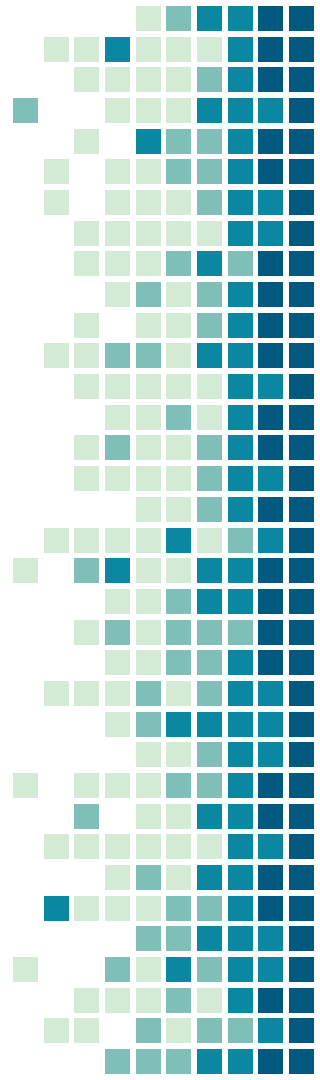
- Travel advisory remains in effect

On Ramp Dates

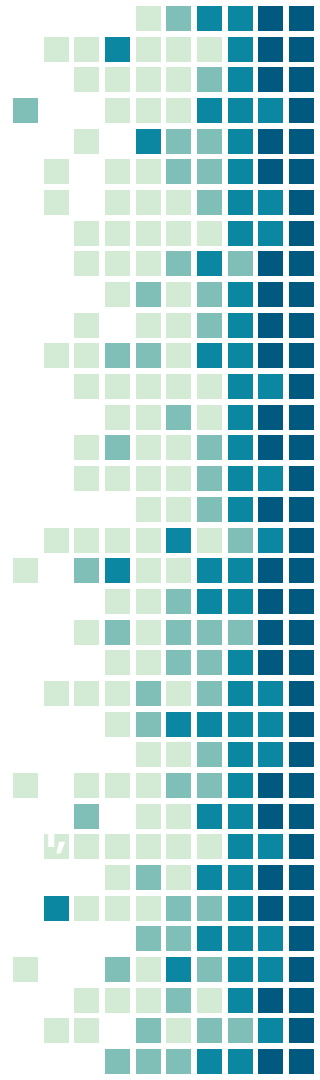
We have carefully considered the calendars and opportunities for students to join in-person instruction as the year continues. Families will be able to work with site principals for joining in-person instruction on the following dates:

- April 19



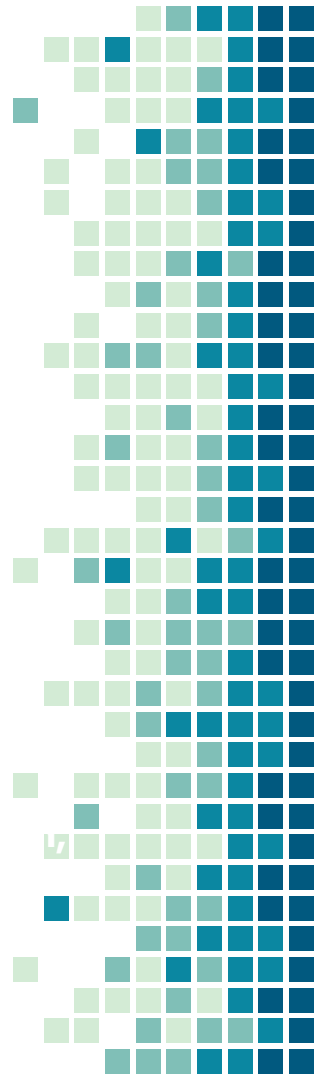

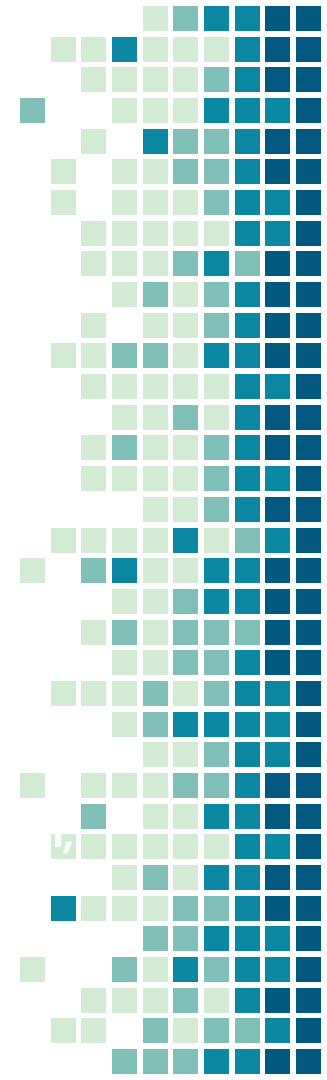

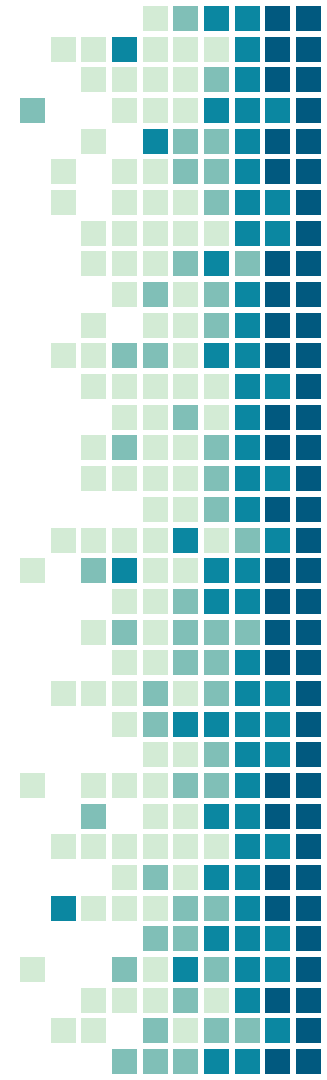
