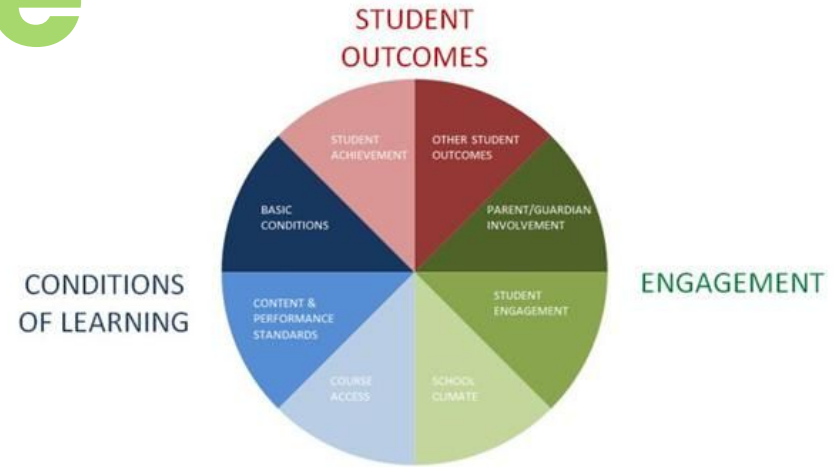

GOAL 1: Meet the individual learning needs of all students.

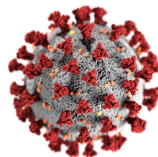
GOAL 2: Support teachers in their design of relevant learning experiences for all students.

Provide tiered supports and systems that promote and sustain strong academics and positive social/emotional development for all students.

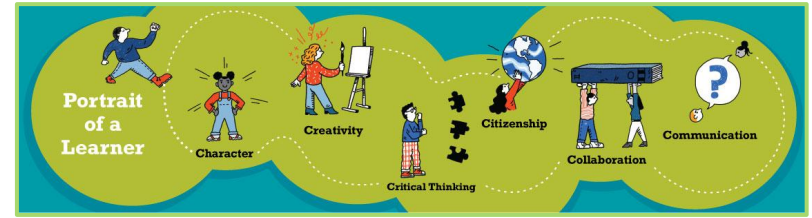
Engagement/Wellness/Safety
