PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:

The proposed equipment will be designed to wrap the following products:

Product Description	Length x Width x Height	Speed
Assorted commissary items	Various	Up to 90 PPM
Tray	8.5" X 6.5" X 1"	Up to 90 PPM

PRODUCT SAMPLES

It will be necessary for you to supply product at two times during the processing of your order. First, 6 samples of each size product listed above will be required for engineering evaluation, design work and order entry. We also need a 6' long sample of each wrapping film required.

After processing your order, our Engineering Department will select up to two of your products for machine checkout and acceptance. Typically, we will select a larger and a smaller product.

About 2-weeks prior to testing, we will require a quantity of each selected product (typically 5 minutes running time worth of product) along with a roll of film for each film width tested. AmeriPak is not responsible for delays in shipment due to a lack of sample product, testing product or wrapping materials. During testing all product setting will be entered into the PLC and touch screen for future to facilitate and minimize changeover time.

WRAPPING MATERIAL

Wrapping material used to over wrap the above products is: Heat sealable 1 mil polypropylene film and 80 gauge polyester film.

OPERATING SPEED

The above noted speed(s) are the target speeds for the application. The speed at which satisfactory seals can be obtained can only be determined after testing and evaluation.

PRODUCT FEEDING

The customer will be responsible for placing product into the flights of the infeed conveyor in an accurate and consistent manner.

EQUIPMENT PROPOSAL

PRODUCT DISCHARGE

The customer will be responsible for handling the product after being conveyed from the discharge conveyor.

GUARDING

The guarding of the wrapper has been arranged for maximum operator safety and includes electrically interlocked guards with electrical safety circuits to automatically stop the equipment under unsafe conditions. All guarding not equipped with electrical interlocks will require tools to remove.

ELECTRICAL SUPPLY

This wrapper will be arranged to receive your electrical supply of 230v, 3phase, 60 hertz with electrical ground. The electrical cabinet and controls are designed to meet N.E.M.A. 1 electrical standards.

PAYMENT TERMS

An initial payment of 50% of the total contract price with the signed contract, an additional 40% due prior to shipment, balance net 30 days after shipment not relating to machine installation. Payment terms are subject to credit approval. Send Purchase Order, signed contract, deposit check, sample product and film to AmeriPak, 364 Valley Rd., Unit 100, Warrington, PA 18976, referencing this proposal number on your Purchase Order. Our fax is 215-343-1633.

NOTE: Price is valid for 30 days from date of proposal. Price is f.o.b. delivered and does not include applicable sales and use taxes. Delinquent accounts will be charged interest on any unpaid balance at the rate of one and one-half percent per month (1-1/2%).

SHIP DATE

We estimate our ship date to be 12 to 14 weeks from date of receipt of your formal order and signed original of this proposal. To enter your order, we require all items noted in PAYMENT TERMS above. Our estimated ship date is based on current production schedules and is subject to change at time order is placed.

MACHINE MANUAL

Two copies of the machine manuals are provided on two USB thumb drives. The manual has sections for operation, setting, maintenance, lubrication, part identification, electrical diagram and a trouble-shooting guide.

TRAINING

Two days of onsite set up and training by a factory trained technician is included. Customer training is conducted free-of-charge at AmeriPak factory as part of the mandatory factory acceptance test. Training and Installation is also available at the customer's location at an extra charge, either through AmeriPak Factory Service Technicians or through Factory Trained AmeriPak distributor technicians.

CUSTOMER'S RESPONSIBILITY

- ✓ Sign off on machine operation at a factory acceptance test prior to shipping.
- ✓ Arrange for safe unloading of the shipment once it arrives at your location.
- ✓ **Platinum Packaging** will check for damage to the shipment upon arrival and report any damage to the carrier.
- ✓ **Platinum Packaging** will uncrate and locate equipment prior to start-up
- ✓ Provide all utilities to the equipment at the desired location. **Connections to be made by Platinum Packaging's field service technician.**
- ✓ Provide mechanical and electrical assistance to the installing technician

WARRANTY

The warranty described herein shall be IN LIEU OF any other warranty, expressed or implied, including but not limited to, any implied warranty of MERCHANTABILITY or fitness for a particular purpose.

2. Seller assumes no responsibility for the quality of performance of wrapping materials, bags, containers, labels, glues, or other materials purchased from others for use with SELLER'S goods.
3. The machinery manufactured by AmeriPak is warranted to be free from defects in material and workmanship for a period of 12 months from the date the equipment is shipped. All parts proving defective during this period, based on AmeriPak examination, will be repaired or replaced free of charge within a reasonable time. This warranty shall not apply if the equipment has not been operated and maintained in accordance with AmeriPak written instructions applicable to such equipment. Such warranty does not apply to wearable or disposable items such as but not limited to heating elements, cutting knives and brake/clutch surfaces.

LIMITATION OF WARRANTY

BUYER agrees that in no event shall the SELLER have any liability for direct damages in excess of the contract price of the goods in respect of which claim is made, and BUYER further agrees that in no event shall SELLER have any liability for loss of use, loss of profits or for any indirect, incidental or consequential damages of any kind.

CANCELLATION

BUYER may cancel all or any of the goods by written notice to the SELLER 60 days prior to the acknowledged shipping date. On receipt of cancellation notice, all work on the goods cancelled will be stopped as promptly as reasonably possible. BUYER agrees to pay to SELLER contract prices for complete goods and SELLER'S full costs (including burden and overhead) plus twenty percent (20%) for incomplete goods. SELLER has the right to complete and ship goods cancelled less than sixty (60) days prior to the acknowledged shipping date.

TITLE – RISK OF LOSS – INSURANCE – ASSIGNMENT

Delivery of the goods, f.o.b. BUYER'S facility, to a carrier or SELLER shall constitute transfer of risk of loss. Title to the goods shall remain with SELLER as a named loss payee until the full purchase price is paid. Neither BUYER nor SELLER shall assign this contract without prior written consent of the other.

COMPLETE CONTRACT

This contract is the final, complete and exclusive statement of the agreement between BUYER and SELLER. No terms, conditions, understandings, usage of the trade, courses or dealing, or agreements purporting to modify, vary, explain, or supplement this contract shall be binding unless and until hereinafter made in writing and signed by BUYER and SELLER.
