

Staff and Student Covid Testing

Surveillance Covid testing has begun for staff and students

- 1,894 tests were provided to staff and students in the last 14 days (5,190 total)
- Tests as of today
 - 783 Staff (1651 total)
 - 1,111 Student (3,539 total)



Vaccinations

- **Every Californian 16 and up are eligible for vaccination as of today, April 15, 2021 - #Vax Day!**
- Approximately 95% of staff have received their second vaccination



Interactive Process Accommodations

264.5 FTE requests for accommodations related to the return to in-person instruction (approximately 25% of all staff)

- Most want to work from home
- The majority are medically related
- Many accommodations will last only until EE is fully vaccinated
- A high percentage are related to child care challenges
 - These will decrease if elementary schools begin to have full days and/or more days of in-person instruction



Interactive Process Accommodations


163 teachers have been provided an accommodation to work from home (for some of part of the year, for some or part of the week)

There are 505 FTEs and 534 actual teachers in SMUHSD

- Of the 163 work from home accommodations:
 - 1 teacher returned on 3/23
 - 1 teacher returned on 4/9
 - 62 teachers returned during the week of 4/12
 - 6 teachers will return during the week of 4/19
 - 6 teachers will return during the week of 4/26
 - 2 teachers will return during the week of 5/3
 - 1 teacher will return on 5/17
 - 1 teacher resigned as of 5/28
 - The remaining 82 teachers will fully return for Fall Semester



Oversight and Decision Making



Stretch Run

- Our safety plan said up to 30% of enrollment would be on campus at any given time.
- We anticipated a model where students came either Monday/Tuesday or Thursday/Friday
- At present we have fewer than thirty percent TOTAL who wish to come back at three schools - Mills, Capuchino, and San Mateo
- At these three schools, all students who expressed an interest in returning will be given the opportunity to come four days a week **STARTING APRIL 26**
- All schools will reach out to families where students are struggling and not coming in for in-person learning and encourage them to come to campus for classes

Site Plans Update

School Site Plans Revision

- Staff will submit revised school site plans to the County tomorrow
- Revisions will allow for students to attend in-person four days per week and up to 50% of student enrollment on campus

 - Basketball, Volleyball, Wrestling
 - Currently practicing
 - Intra-district competitions only
 - Covid-19 testing 48 hours before competition
 - Decision on spectators TBD
