

Naming of Schools and School Buildings

It is the policy of the Paso Robles Joint Unified School District that district schools be named consistent with the following regulations.

K-8 Schools

All schools shall be named after former educators who served the Paso Robles Public Schools with distinction.

9-12 Schools

All new schools constructed after June 1, 1987, shall be named after former educators who served the Paso Robles Joint Union High School District with distinction. (This policy does not apply to the existing schools--Paso Robles High School and Liberty High School.)

9-12 Athletic Fields

Upon request of patrons of the district, the Governing Board may convene the School Naming Committee to consider the naming of high school athletic fields. Such fields shall not have been previously named and may only be named after former teachers or coaches who, in the opinion of the naming committee, have distinguished themselves in the cause of school athletics.

School Buildings

School buildings are to be unnamed. No building shall be named after a person either living or dead.

The Board further establishes the School Naming Committee to be appointed by the Board. This committee shall be comprised of former district educators. The committee shall make recommendations for the naming of sites. The committee shall serve for life or until such time as a member resigns or is no longer able to serve. Following the recommendations of the Naming Committee the Board shall choose the name for the school or field.
