



BICYCLE USE

The Board of Education believes it is the responsibility of the parent to work with the school to promote student safety, whenever possible. In conformance with the California Vehicle Code, students who operate or ride as a passenger on a bicycle, non-motorized *or motorized* scooter, skateboard, *or in-line or traditional roller skates* upon a street, bikeway, or any other public bicycle path or trail shall wear a properly fitted and fastened bicycle helmet that meets the standards of law (Vehicle Code [21212](#)). ~~Students also shall be required to wear such helmets while wearing in-line or roller skates.~~

As a further measure of safety, students in grade levels K-2 shall not be permitted to ride bicycles to school.

Adherence to this policy relative to bicycle use shall be monitored by staff with student and community involvement. The helmet provisions of the Vehicle Code shall be enforced by the Irvine Police Department.
