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AB/SB 86: Highlights



	In-person Instruction Grants	Expanded Learning Opportunities Grants
Spending Time frame	BUSD Receives: \$ 6.7 M Funds must be spent by August 31, 2022	BUSD Receives: \$ 6.6 M Funds must be spent by August 31, 2022
Purpose	To support opening to in-person instruction	To support learning recovery
Funding Calculation	LCFF proportion	\$1,000 per each Homeless student enrolled And LCFF proportion
Apportionment	May 15 (50%) and August 15 (50%)	May 15 (50%) and August 15 (50%)
Qualifying Expenses	Any purpose consistent with providing in-person instruction	Supplemental instruction Must submit a Learning Recovery Plan
To Receive Funds	Offer in-person instruction by April 1st (pro-rated up to May 15th)	Adopt and post plan by June 1st (submit to COE w/in 5 days)

Expanded Learning Opportunities Grant (ELO)

To improve academic achievement by offering supplemental instruction and support to students

- \$1,000 for each homeless student (\$221,000)
- Must use at least 85% for in-person services (\$5,654,017)
- Must use at least 10% to hire paraprofessionals (\$643,879)

Requires **Stakeholder feedback** - Presentation and Feedback sessions:

- Principals/Administrators
- PAC/DELAC
- LEARNS/BEARS Site Supervisors
- EAC & Other Staff Members

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Proposed Spending

Expenditure	Amount
Extending instructional learning time	\$1,408,535
Accelerating progress to close learning gaps through the implementation, expansion, or enhancement of learning supports	\$816,000
Integrated student supports to address other barriers to learning	\$3,612,157
Community learning hubs that provide students with access to technology, high-speed internet, and other academic supports	\$325,000
Supports for credit deficient students to complete graduation or grade promotion requirements and to increase or improve students' college eligibility	\$150,193
Additional academic services for students	\$179,900
Training for school staff on strategies to engage students and families in addressing students' social-emotional health and academic needs	\$160,000
Total	\$6,651,785
