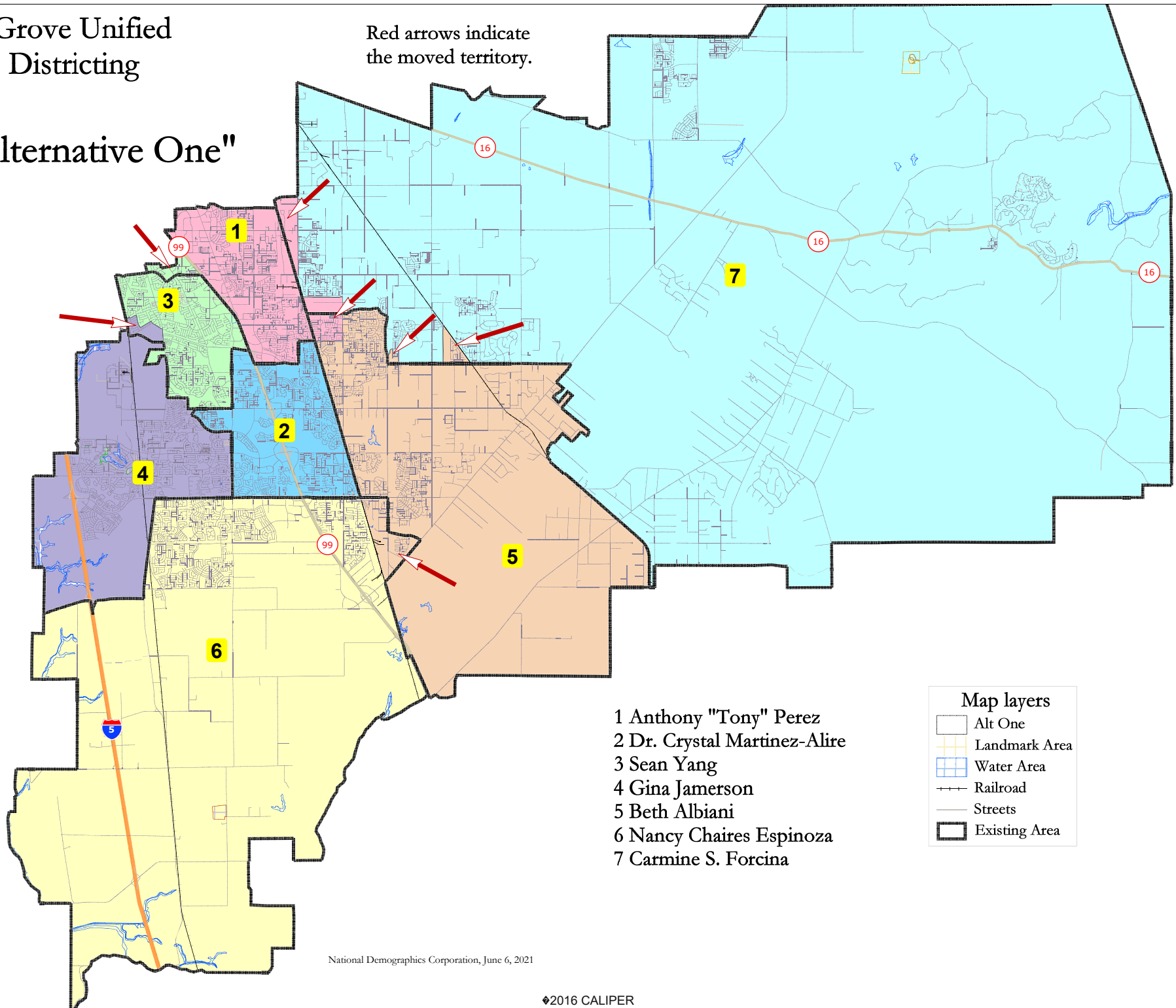


Elk Grove Unified 2021 Districting
