COVID-19 Impact

- 2020-2021 began in distance learning
- Return to in-person learning:
 - Students receiving special education services (October 2020)
 - Elementary and 6th grade (February 1, 2021)
 - 7th and 8th grade (early Spring 2021)

General Information

- No CAASPP in Spring 2020
- CAASPP in 2021 was optional across the state
- Shorter form test (reduced blueprint by 50%)
- No claim scores due to smaller blueprint
- Scores have been decoupled from accountability
- Statewide and county data are not available until late fall
- Fewer students opted to take the test

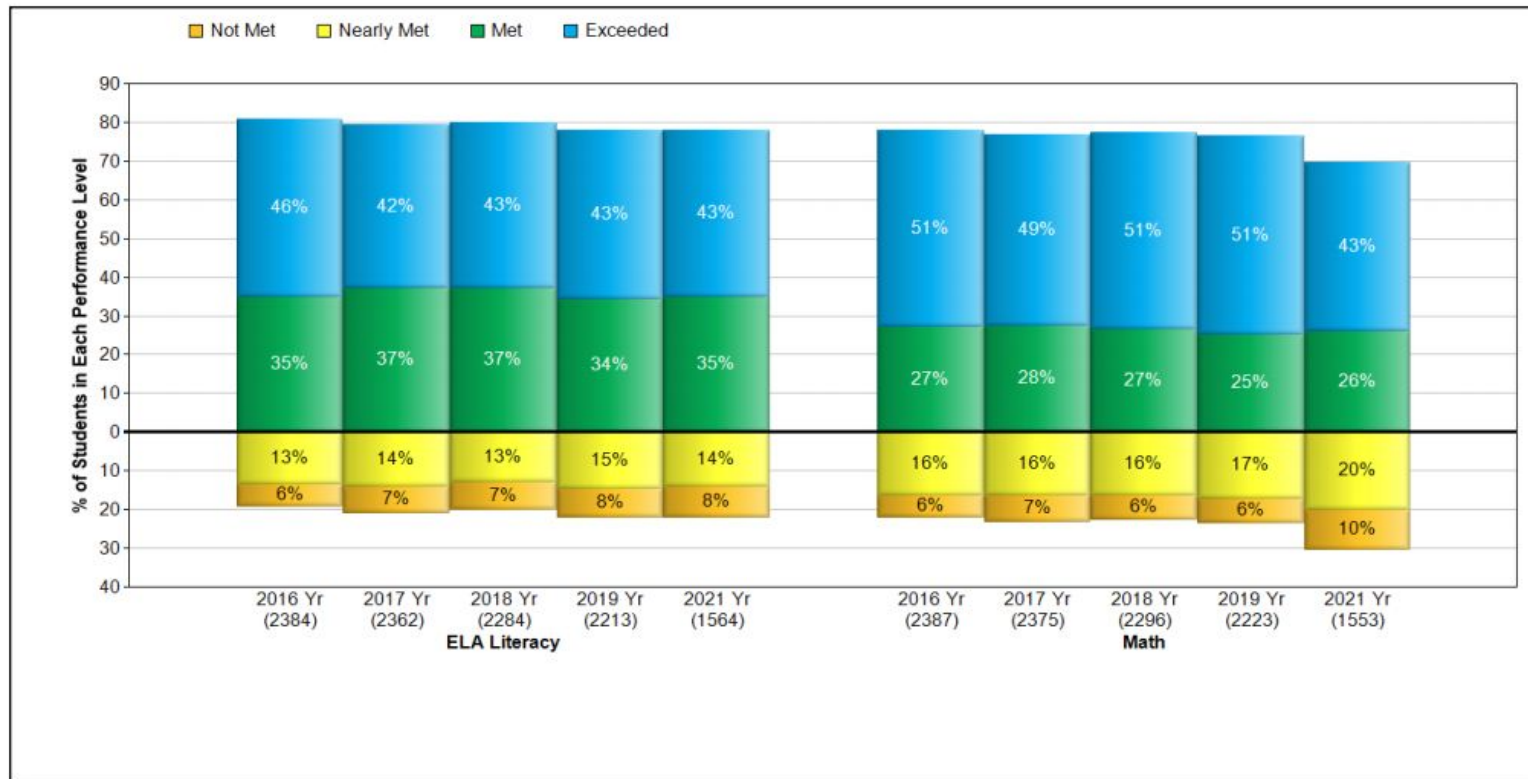

District-Wide (grades 3-8) Trends

- LGUSD Positive Trends:
 - LGUSD maintained high levels of achievement during a pandemic
 - ELA Literacy scores maintained compared to past year
 - Lexington math scores show some improvement
- Areas for Growth:
 - Math scores in current grades 7 and 8 (reflected in 2021 6th and 7th grades CAASPP reports)

Next Steps

- Continue district-wide professional development in the areas of effective instructional and assessment practices aligned with the Common Core Standards (K-8)
- Site leaders are working with their teachers on plans to address learning disruption
- Use of Math MARS task to increase and expand mathematical thinking
- Administer at leader one SBAC interim assessment in Math and ELA
- Support to the Fisher math team to address middle school needs

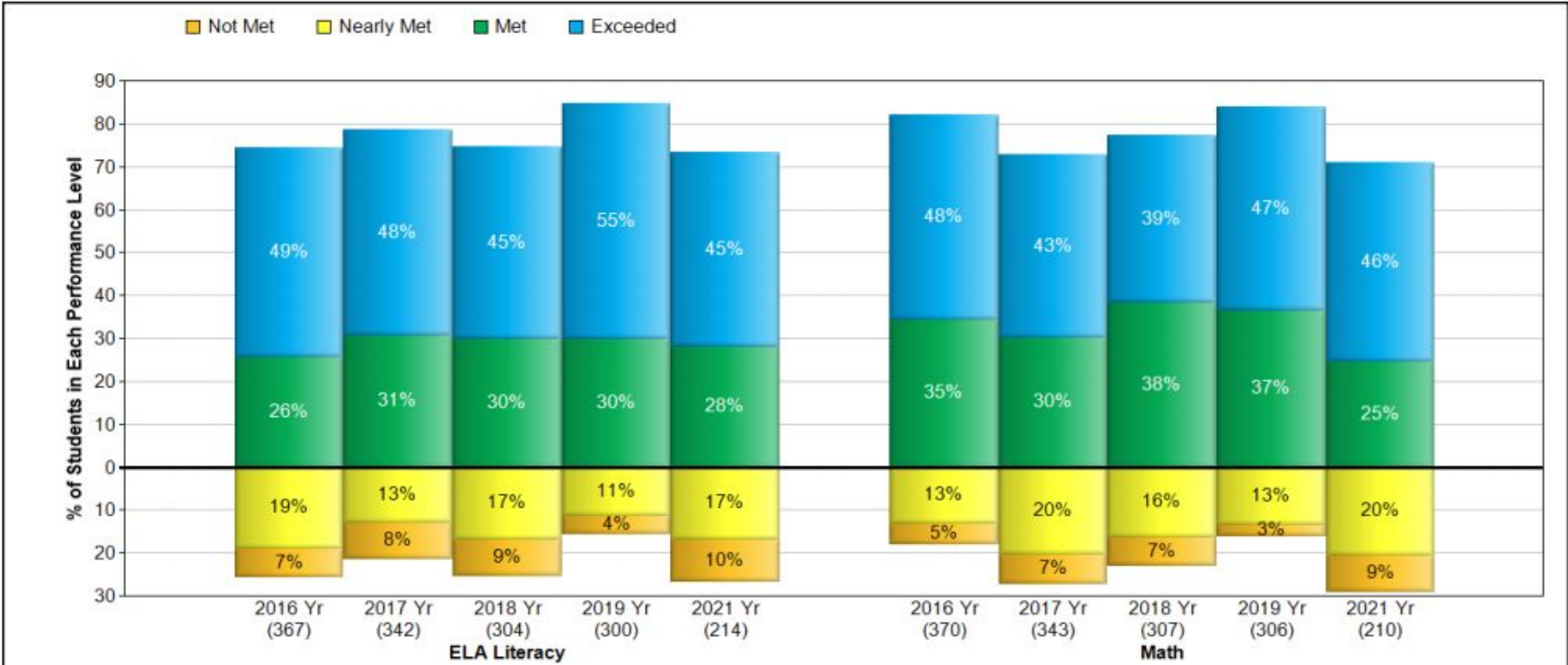

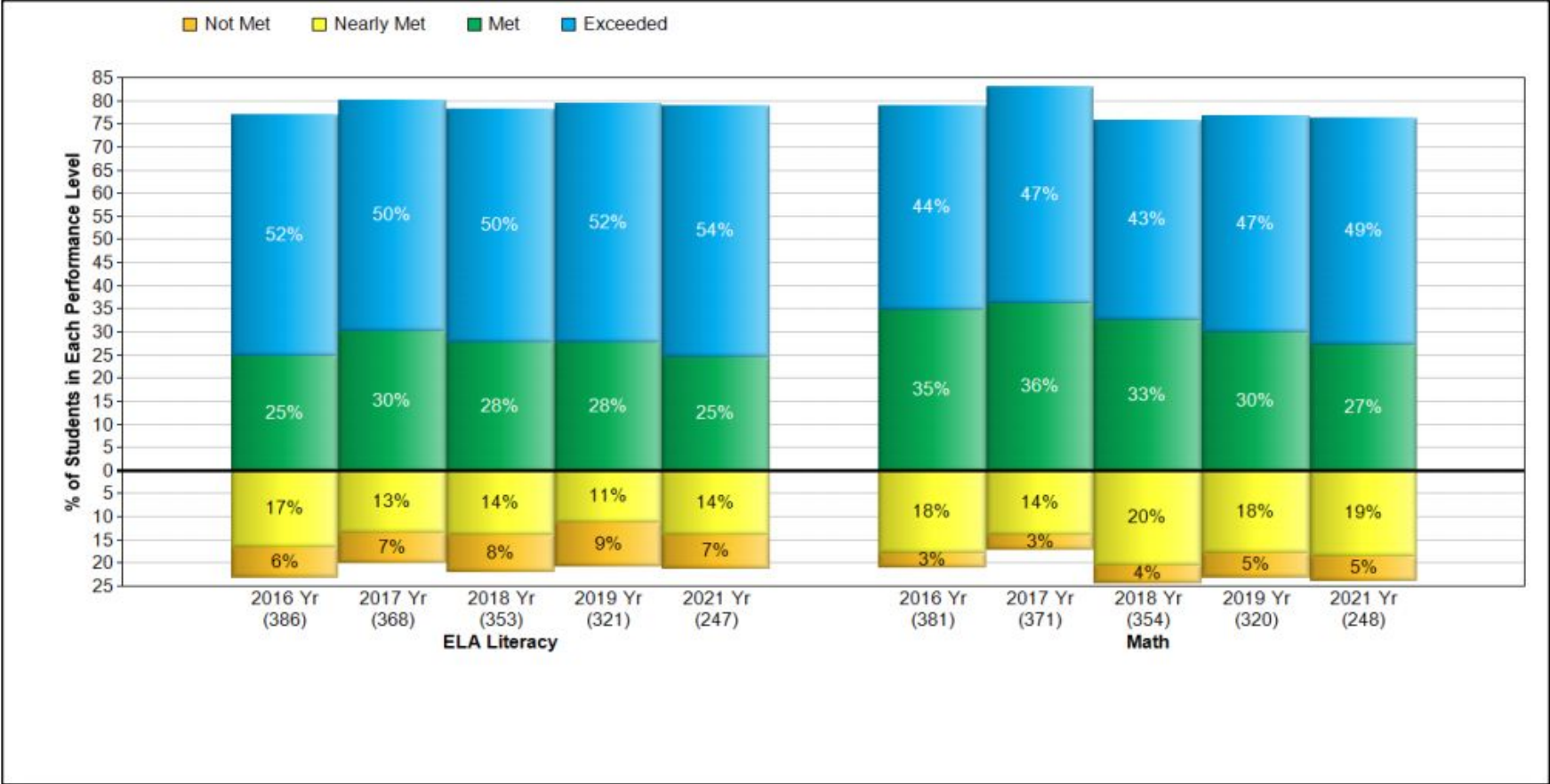

* Each bar represents the distribution of students testing that term, showing the percentage at each achievement level.

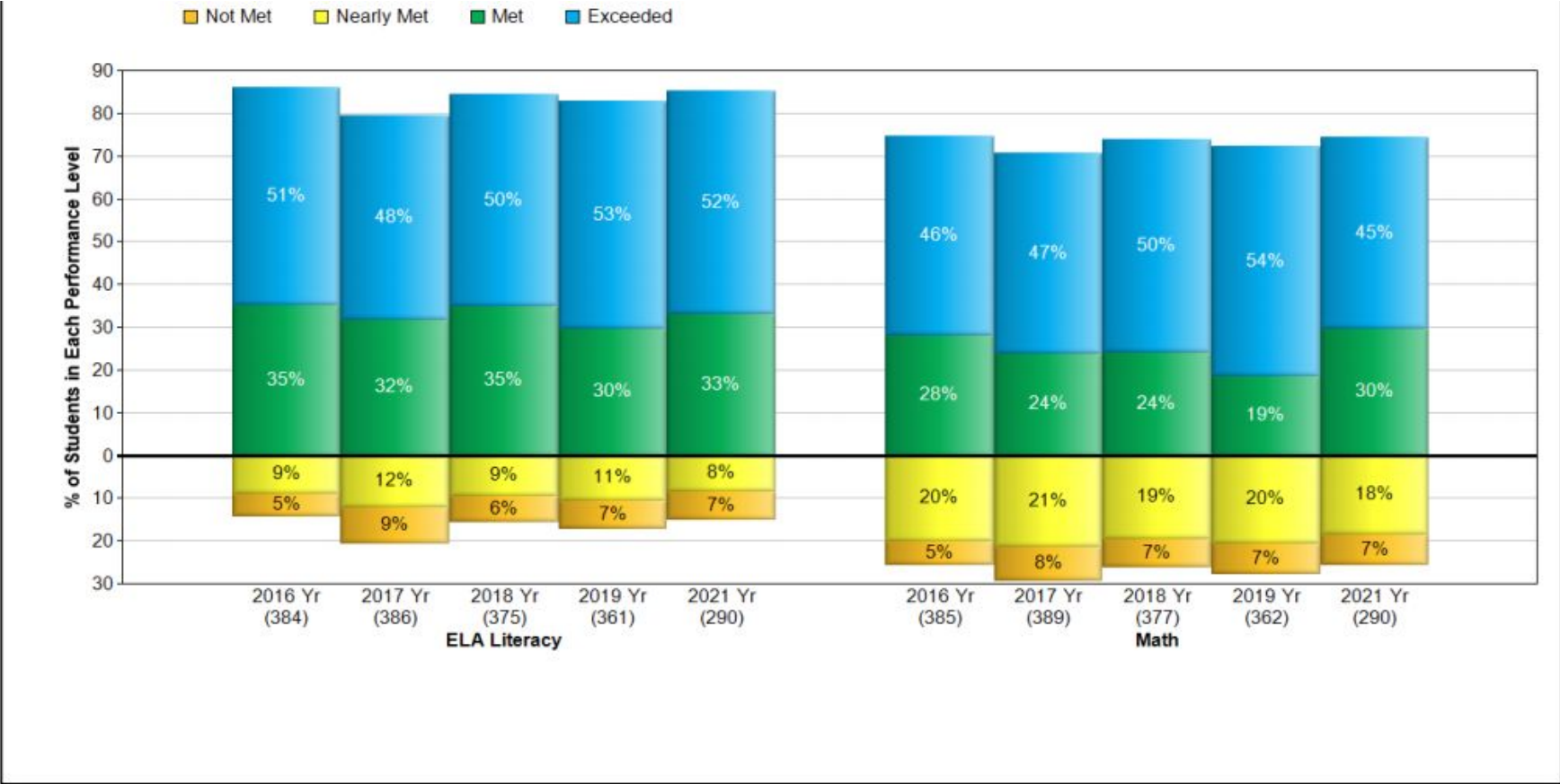


Appendix B: District 4th grade Results

* Each bar represents the distribution of students testing that term, showing the percentage at each achievement level.

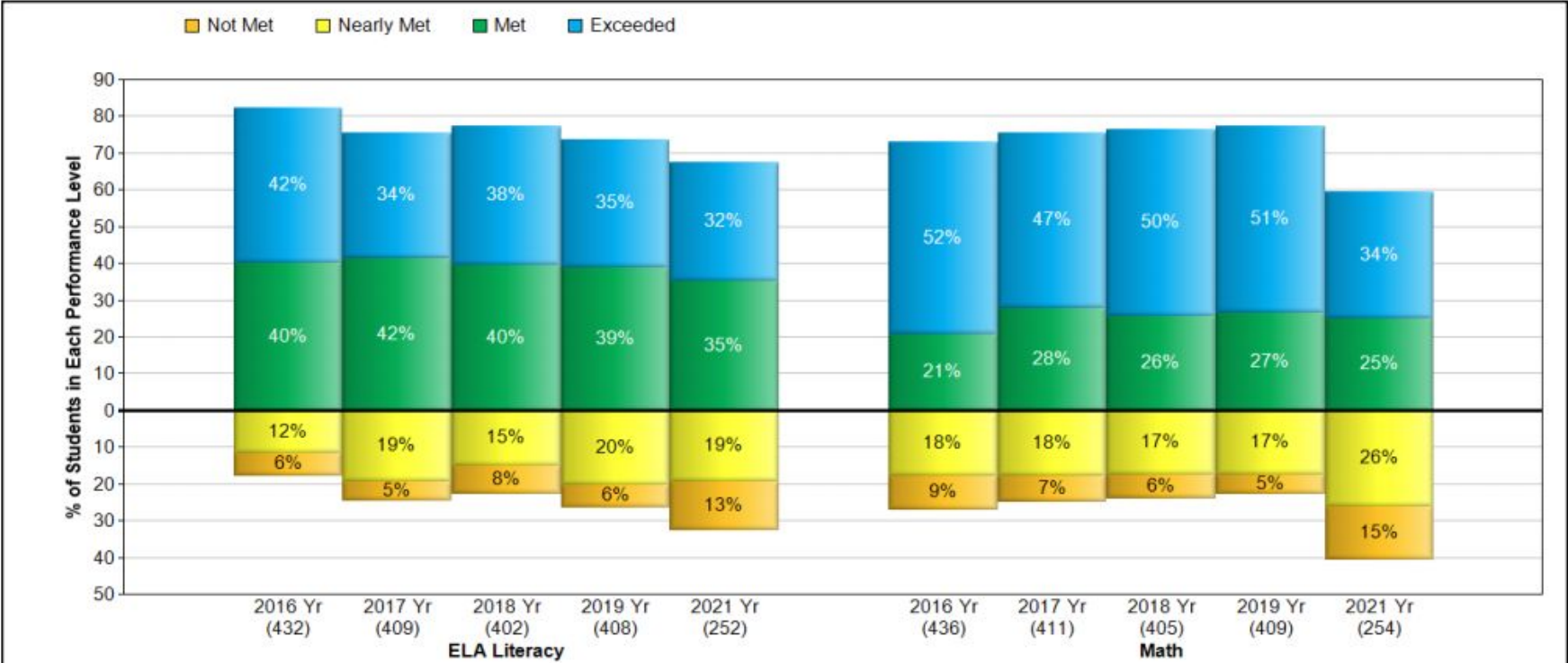

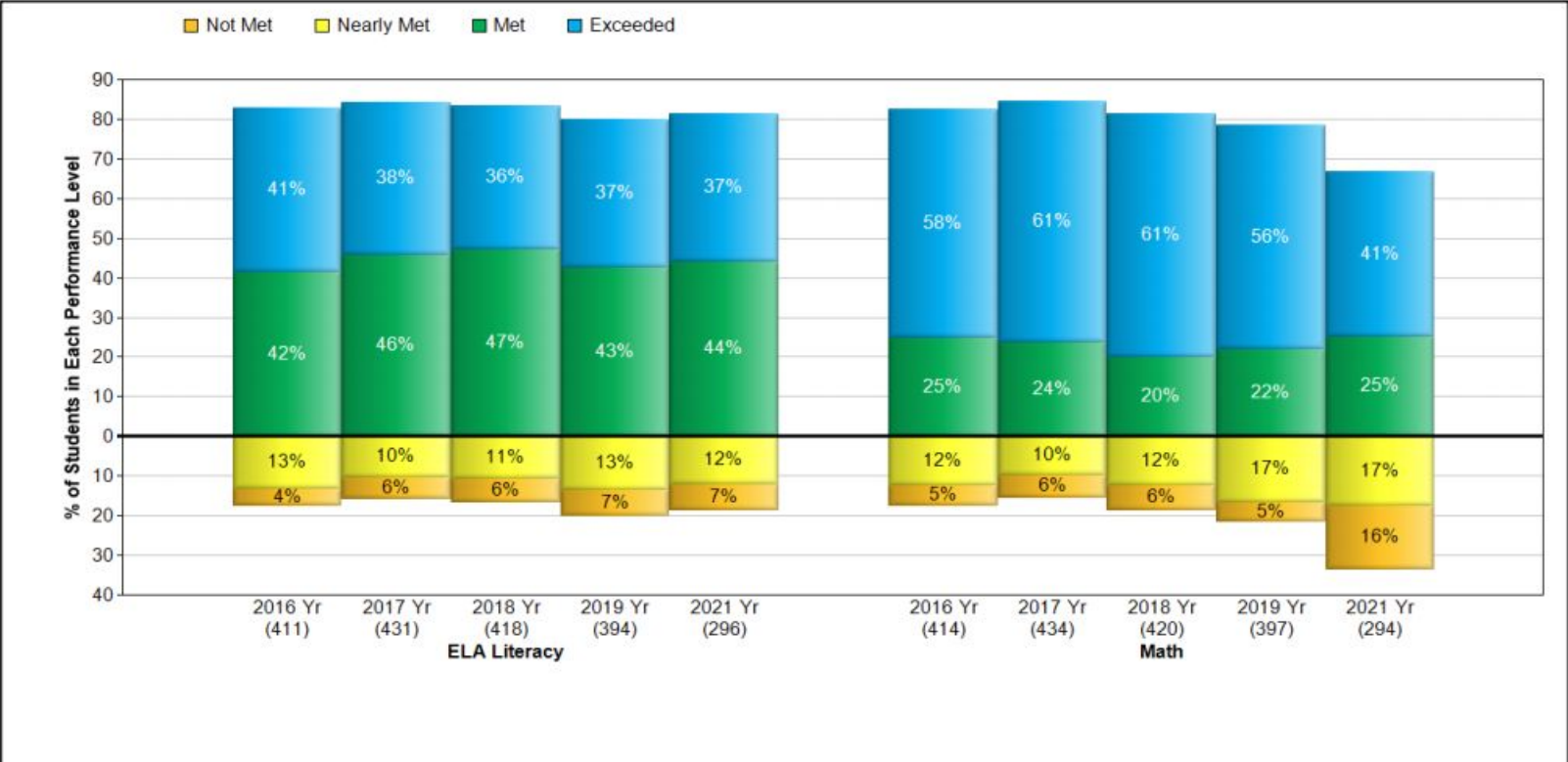
