RESOLUTION NO. 09/21-22 ASSURING COMPLIANCE WITH EDUCATION CODE SECTION 60119 REGARDING SUFFICIENCY OF INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022

WHEREAS, the Governing Board of the San Mateo-Foster City School District, in order to comply with the requirements of Education Code 60119, held a public hearing on October 7, 2021 at 6:30 PM, which did not take place during or immediately following school hours, and;

WHEREAS, the Board provided at least 10 days notice of the public hearing by posting it in at least three public places within the district stating the time, place, and purpose of the hearing, and;

WHEREAS, the Board encouraged participation by parents/guardians, teachers, members of the community, and bargaining unit leaders in the public hearing, and;

WHEREAS, information provided at the public hearing detailed the extent to which textbooks and instructional materials were provided to all students, including English Learners, in the San Mateo-Foster City School District at Abbott Middle School, The Bayside Academy, Borel and Bowditch Middle Schools, Audubon, Baywood, Beach Park, Beresford, Brewer Island, College Park, Fiesta Gardens International School, Foster City, George Hall, Highlands, Lead, Laurel, Meadow Heights, North Shoreview Montessori, Parkside Montessori, San Mateo Park and Sunnybrae Elementary Schools, and;

WHEREAS, the definition of “sufficient textbooks or instructional materials” means that each student, including English Learners, has a textbook or instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home, and;

WHEREAS, between the 2008-2009 through the 2021-2022 fiscal years, the definition of “sufficient textbooks and instructional materials” also means that all students who are enrolled in the same course with the San Mateo-Foster City School District, have standards-aligned textbooks or instructional materials from the same adoption cycles, and;

WHEREAS, sufficient textbooks and instructional materials were provided to each student, including English learners, that are aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks in the following subjects: Mathematics, Science, History-Social Science and English Language Arts, including the English Language Development Program for English Learners,

WHEREAS, all instructional materials used as the primary text for all subjects are adopted by the Board of Trustees, and are consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that: For the school year 2021-2022, the

San Mateo-Foster City School District's schools, Abbott Middle School, The Bayside Academy, Borel and Bowditch Middle Schools, Audubon, Baywood, Beresford, Beach Park, Brewer Island, College Park, Fiesta Gardens International, Foster City, George Hall, Highlands, Lead, Laurel, Meadow Heights, North Shoreview Montessori, Parkside Montessori, San Mateo Park and Sunnybrae Elementary Schools have provided each student with sufficient standards-based textbooks and instructional materials aligned to the academic content standard and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks.
