



Proclamation/Resolution No. 2021/2022-6
Recognizing October 2021 as LGBTQ+ History Month

Whereas, the Ravenswood City School District respects the rights, freedom, and equality of those who are lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer (LGBTQ+); and

Whereas, all students deserve to feel safe and welcome in their schools and to learn about historical figures who are LGBTQ+ and have achieved greater equality for all people through civic, legislative, and judicial action; and

Whereas, on July 14, 2011, the Fair, Accurate, Inclusive, and Respectful (FAIR) Education Act was signed into law, mandating that instruction in history-social sciences include the contributions of LGBT individuals to the economic, political, and social development of California and the United States of America; and

Whereas, on July 14, 2016, the State Board of Education adopted a new History-Social Science Framework that ensures that the roles and contributions of LGBTQ+ people and people with disabilities are accurately portrayed in K-12 history instruction in California classrooms; and

Whereas, Ravenswood City School District recognizes and celebrates October 2021 as LGBTQ+ History Month

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Ravenswood City School District affirms the commitment to ensuring the rich history of the LGBTQ+ community is shared.
