BHS Consent Education

2020-21

- BHS SHAC (Sexual Harm Advisory committee) was formed in December 2020
- The primary purpose behind this was to create a committee that consisted of members who are directly part of BHS* (students and staff) so that we could engage in the work of shifting our school's culture (related to sexual harm) from within

*the one exception we made was including our district's Title IX Investigator on this committee

Intentional Recruitment - In an effort to be inclusive and promote a diversity of voice, we recruited staff and students from various groups on campus with the hopes of having representation from:

- Small Learning Communities (AC, AHA, AMPS, BIHS, CAS)
- Universal 9th Grade (U9)
- Multilingual Program (MLP)
- Teachers, counselors, classified staff, and administrators

- various demographic groups (gender, race, sexual orientation)

- varied lived experiences with regards to sexual harm

BHS SHAC Goal #1:

- Select a consent education vendor for BHS
 - Participate in interview process to provide feedback, rate candidates, and put forth a recommendation for hire to Dr. Stephens

BHS SHAC Goal #2:

- Provide feedback on activities/issues related to consent education and sexual harm at BHS.
- So far this has included providing feedback on:
 - Consent Education Week 2020-21
 - Presentation for BHS Student Consent Education 2021-22 (student focus group reviewed slide deck and gave input to customize for BHS audience)
 - Presentation for BHS Staff 2021-22

Additional BHS Consent Education 2021-22

- BHS Peer Consent Education Team created a peer-led presentation that was offered as a virtual classroom presentation to all BHS teachers during Consent Education Week (62 classes signed up and roughly 1,800 students received the training)
- This presentation was largely created by students and was reviewed by our BUSD Title IX Coordinator and Compliance Officer and by staff advisors (myself and Ms. Jasdeep Malhi)
- We met regularly (weekly or bi-weekly) in the spring and the presentations took place in May

Moving forward: BHS Consent Education 2021-22

- BHS SHAC staff members met to provide feedback on the 10/11 Staff Development Day PD presentation on Consent Education for staff
- BHS SHAC student members met with Shafia Zaloom to provide feedback on upcoming Consent Education presentations for students (taking place next week)
- BHS SHAC (existing members) had first whole group meeting today during lunch

Moving forward: BHS Consent Education 2021-22

- Actively recruiting more staff and students to fill vacancies created by graduating seniors and staff who no longer work at BHS
- Additional members of BHS SHAC this year will also include representatives from BHS Stop Harassing, BHS Sexual Harm Reduction Team, ASB, Student Leadership and Women's Student Union* (WSU)

*BHS SHAC already had representation from WSU last year and she is still an active member
