President Griffin asked that you join him in a moment of silence for two members of our SMUHSD community who passed away recently.

Charlotte Frances Murdoff, a senior at Burlingame High School, passed away at the age of 18 September 22 after a long battle with cancer.

Char attended North Hillsborough School and Crocker Middle School. Char's favorite sport was soccer for which she spent most of her youth playing. She made many lasting friendships through her soccer teammates and had a left foot that could send a ball soaring into the corner of the net. When handed the diagnosis of osteosarcoma prior to the start of her freshman year, Charlotte used her fierce competitive spirit to battle this rare bone cancer. She stayed positive, resilient and strong throughout the course of her disease.

Char spent all of high school in and out of treatment and always with a beautiful smile on her face. She loved going onto the Burlingame High School campus for classes, lunch period or sporting events. When cancer eliminated most of Charlotte's athletic options, she pivoted and learned to play golf, making a spot on the BHS Varsity golf team. Char celebrated good days and got through bad days, keeping a positive attitude and facing challenges like the true warrior she was. Char was funny, determined, stubborn, creative, full of grit and yet a sweet friend to all. There is no one quite like Charlotte, she will be missed by all who knew her.

Bill Daskarolis passed away on September 26 at the age of 83.

Affectionately referred to as "Dasko", Bill started teaching at Aragon in 1963 and retired from teaching in 1997. He served as athletic director from 1971 until 1996 and was head track and cross country coach until 2017, 20 years after retiring from teaching. Dasko is in the Peninsula

Sports Hall of Fame, the Crystal Spring Course Hall of Fame, the Aragon Hall of Fame and was awarded a lifetime achievement award by the California Association of Coaches. He also received the Central Coast Section's prestigious Distinguished Service Award. In 2014 the Aragon track was officially named the Bill Daskarolis track.

Bill took great pride in his relationships with faculty members across all departments and was masterful at working with the different principals at Aragon. Many considered Bill to be a dear friend who was loved and respected. Aragon has indeed lost another icon.
