The College notified all parents and students that the campus was going to be closed at 6:53 am on August 30, 2021. Since the College Campus houses GECA, our school was closed that day and all classes were canceled.

Section B: School Closure – Mt. Madonna Continuation High School

Part I: Nature of Emergency

Mt. Madonna High School was closed from September 14, 2021, through October 29, 2021 due to an infestation of fleas. Despite the District's efforts to quickly respond and professionally treat for fleas – eggs kept hatching and stray cats and mammals surrounding the campus were thought to be a part of the problem.

The District hired Advance IPM to spray the exterior of the campus as early as August 21, 2021. The Summary Report (attached) from Advanced IPM points to stray cats around the back of the campus. Stray cats and other mammals (squirrels, gophers) were thought to be carrying fleas onto the campus.

The Governing Board approved Emergency Site Improvements at Mt. Madonna High School to target the areas harvesting fleas for a total cost of \$177,752. Unfortunately, despite the efforts of our contractor, the rains in October did delay the pouring of the concrete and students were back on campus until Monday, November 1, 2021. The District is requesting approval of ADA waiver for the 33 instructional days the campus was closed due to the health and safety of students and staff.

Chronology of events:

School started on August 16, 2021.

Evidence of fleas were reported on August 19, 2021.

- September 16, 2021 -GUSD School Board approved Emergency Site Improvements (\$85,376).
- September 23, 2021 -School Board approved additional scope of work to address the front of the campus – fleas still present – (\$92,376)
- November 1, 2021 – students back on campus!



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CAMPUS CLOSED on **September 14, 2021**. The treatments proved to be insufficient as the source harvesting fleas remained. The fleas were taking shelter on 3 wooden sheds, and mammals were living underneath the dirt in the lunch areas, and back perimeter of the school.

EMERGENCY SITE IMPROVEMENTS

The District solicited a quote from EF&S Concrete to isolate the areas that are thought to harvest fleas and other insects. The scope of work includes the following:

1. Demolish the three (3) wooden sheds
2. Eliminate about 9,147 square feet of dirt area and replace with concrete.
3. Purchase and install three (3) new metal sheds
4. Lunch area was infested with fleas. This dirt area was converted into concrete as well. Area was approximately 6,747 sq. ft.

The above emergency improvements were aimed at direct removal of flea infested areas, and eliminated the environments that thought to be harvesting fleas. This was an emergency due to the health and safety of our students and staff. Many had reported several flea bites despite the efforts of the District to eradicate the fleas.

On-going Routine Treatment

Prior to the students coming back to campus, the District custodial staff monitored flea traps and cleaned daily. Advanced IPM was also hired to do a last application on the new site improvements. Advance IPM also uses the EPA exempt Essentria IC-3 at all of the sites as a regular treatment. The IC-3 has proven to be a safe and effective general insect treatment around our District.

Feral Cats

The District will continue to reach out to its animal control consultant to trap and release cats outside the school area.

Request from the Gilroy Unified School District

The District is requesting a waiver of ADA for the 33 instructional days Mt. Madonna Continuation High School was closed due to the flea infestation, under conditions described in Education Code 41422.

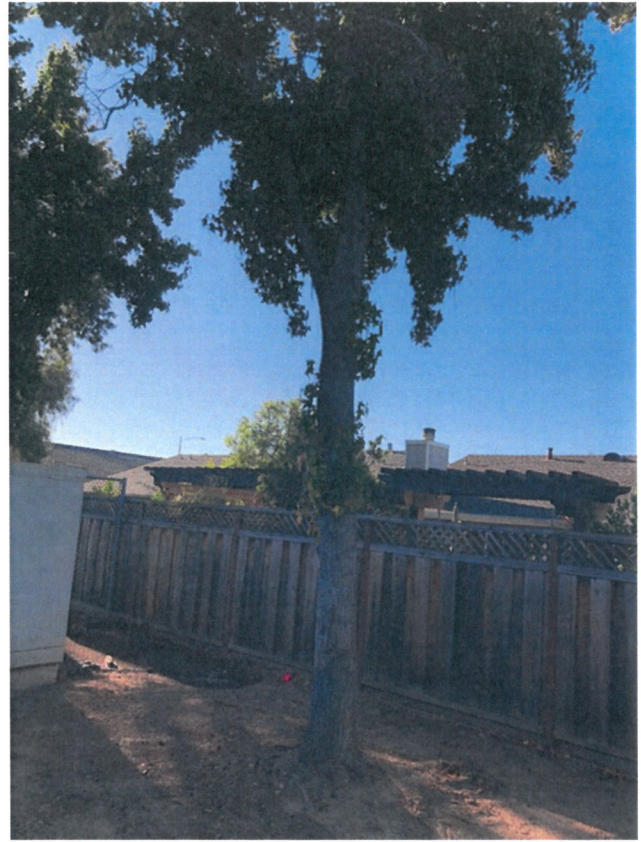
