# CABE Multilingual Masterplan Development

Leadership Team Composition: District and site administrators, ELD Teachers, BREA TSAs, Classified Bargaining Unit Staff, DELAC Co-Chairs (2), EL Parents (2)

- **PD Session 1: Initial EL/Multilingual Learner Masterplan Workshop - 12/7/2021** - (Aligned with Goal 6/MOU)
  - Review of current EL Masterplan to identify areas of that require updates and revisions
  - Background building on aspects linked to federal, state, and local accountability systems
  - Sample EL Master Plans will be shared to begin identification of areas to revise
- **Data/Survey Meeting: CABE, BREA, and District Staff - 12/8/2021**
  - Surveys will be created and sent out to parents, community members, staff, and students to obtain feedback
- **PD Session 2: EL Roadmap Policy: Mapping the Journey to Success at the District/Site - 12/14/2021** - (Aligned with Goal 2/MOU)

# CABE Project 2 Inspire

- Project 2 Inspire compliments the work of the Multilingual Masterplan for parents and community members

- CABE met with district staff to finalize parent outreach plan for Project 2 Inspire (25-40 parents)
  - ELD teachers were requested to personally invite parents at their sites to attend
  - Principals were also solicited to personally invite parents at their sites to attend

# PIQE (Parent Institute for Quality Education)

Target Audience: Parent and Community Members

- Two Cohorts - Sites were chosen based on data that depicted the Latinx/EL Population at the sites
- Cohort 1:
  - Elementary - Sylvia Mendez & Thousand Oaks
  - Middle School - Longfellow & MLK
  - Sessions begin 2/16/22
    - Sessions are 8 weeks
    - One session a week for 75 minutes
- Cohort 2:
  - Elementary - Rosa Parks & Malcolm X
  - Highschool - Berkeley High & Berkeley Tech
  - Sessions begin 3/10/22
    - Sessions are 8 weeks
    - One session a week for 75 minutes
