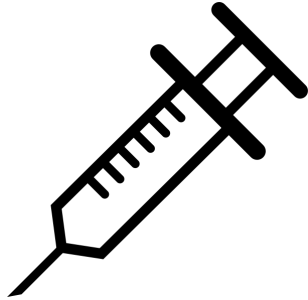

# What do we know about Omicron?



- Omicron is in the US... but 99% of US cases are still Delta variant
- Omicron has mutations that may make re-infections more likely, even if vaccinated
- Not yet clear if it causes more / less serious symptoms
- CDPH emphasizes importance of “vaccinations and boosters to prevent serious illness and deaths”
- Testing & isolation important also

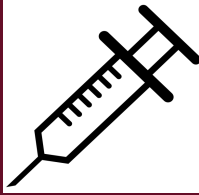

# Local vaccination rates are fairly high; We need to get 5-11 year olds vaccinated

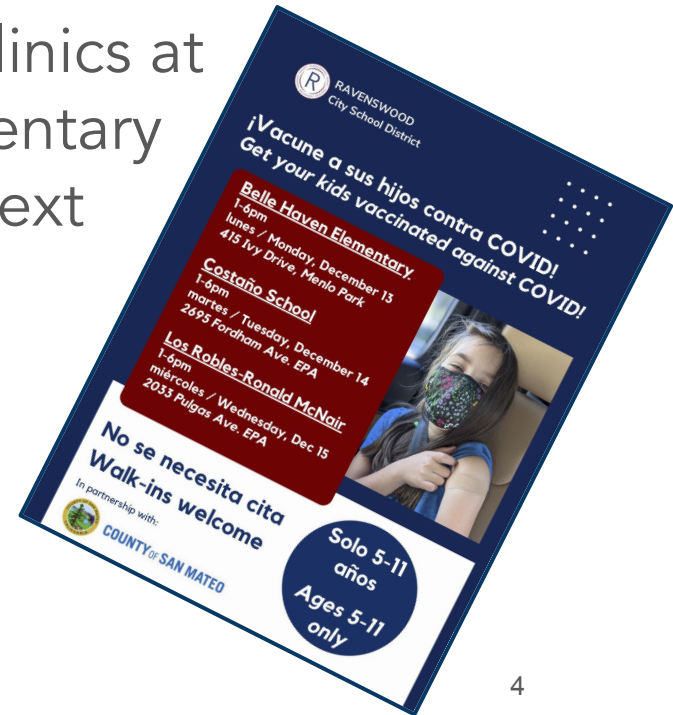

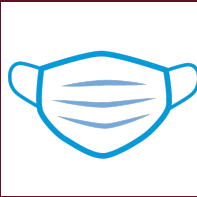

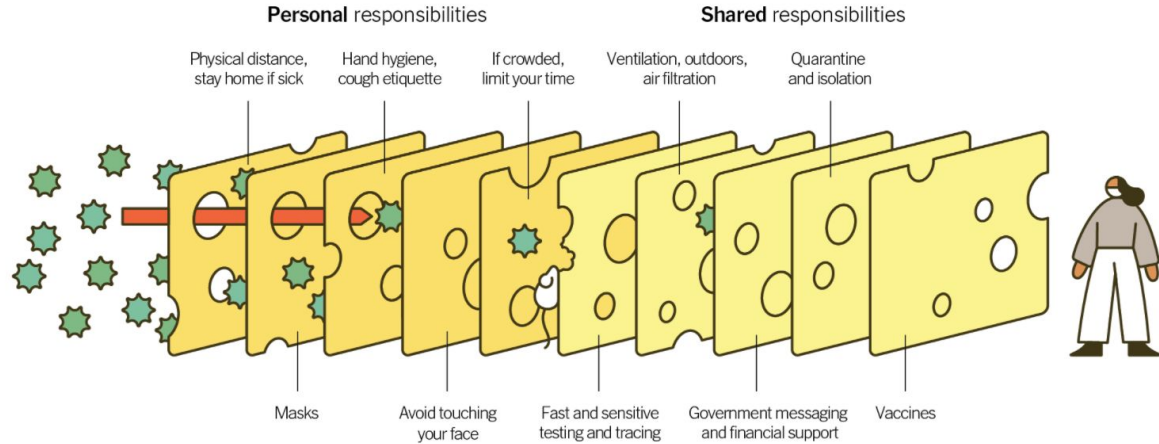


# We continue to follow CDPH and County guidelines to keep students and staff safe

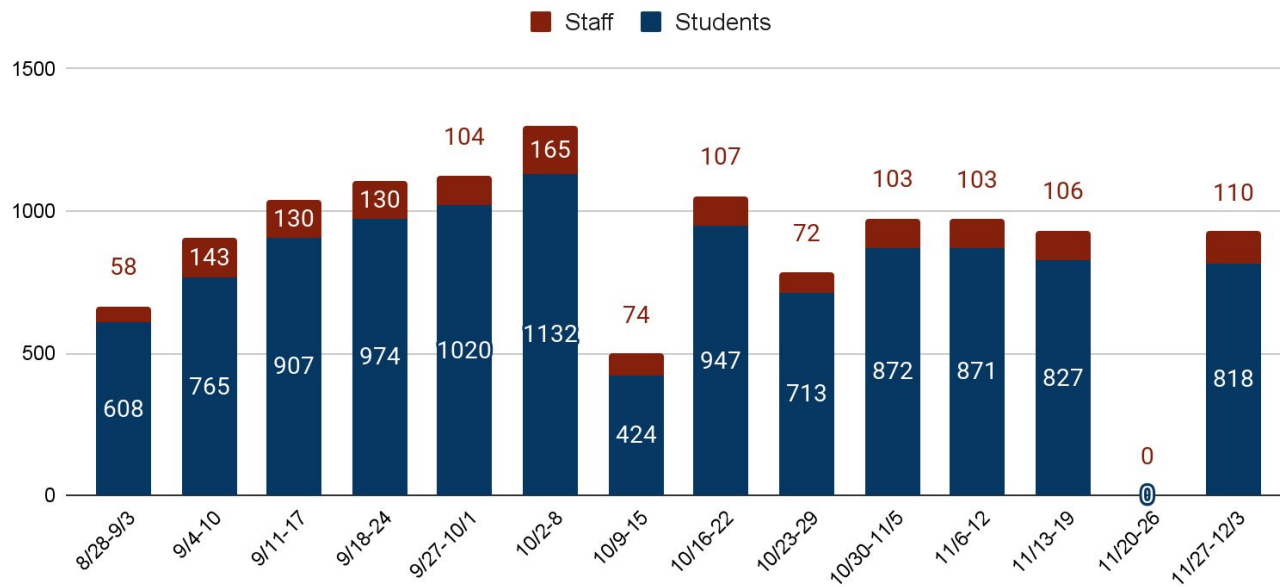

# We are testing almost 1,000 students and staff every week

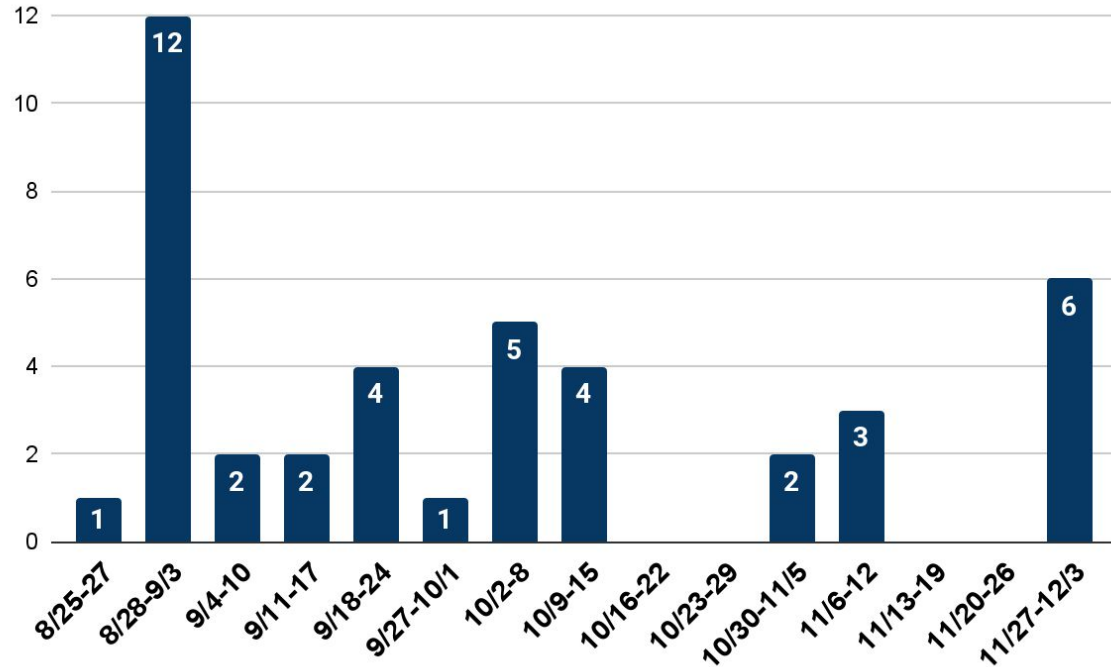


## Number of COVID Tests Administered, by week
