The mission of the Castro Plaza Family Resource Center (FRC) is to improve the quality of life and strengthen the individual children, and families of North Monterey County.

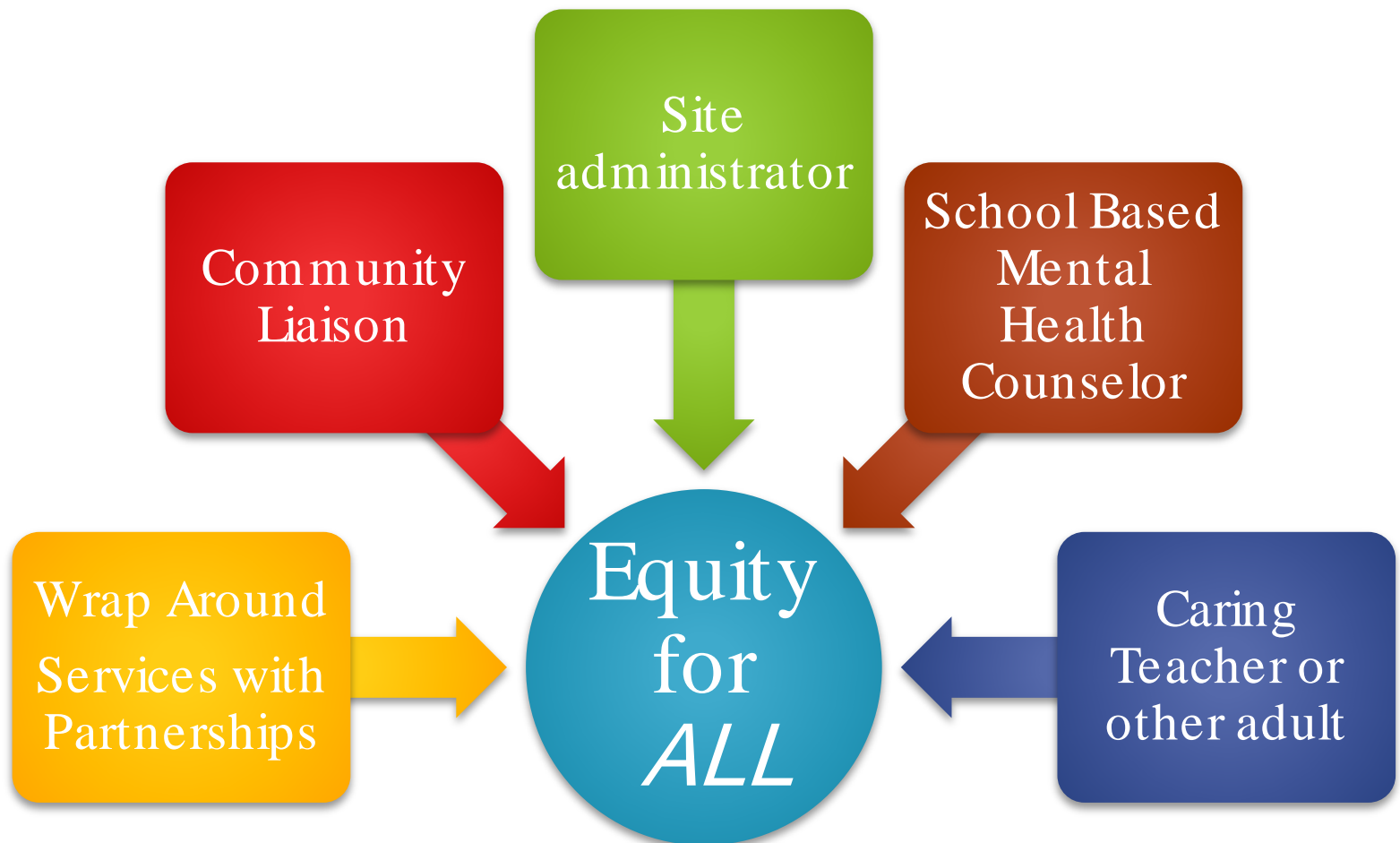
