**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE ELK GROVE
UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT AUTHORIZING EMERGENCY
CONTRACTS FOR THE REMOVAL AND REPAIR OF FIRE DAMAGE IN
THE SHELDON HIGH SCHOOL L WING BUILDING,
8333 KINGSBRIDGE DRIVE, SACRAMENTO, CALIFORNIA**

WHEREAS, Public Contract Code Section 20113 provides that in the case of an emergency, where repair work is necessary to avoid danger to life and property and to permit the continuance of existing school classes, this Board may, by unanimous vote, and with the approval of the County Superintendent of Schools, contract for the repair of public facilities required by that emergency without the solicitation of bids; and

WHEREAS, the event was discovered by the District on December 13, 2021;
and

WHEREAS, the discovery and fire damage showed specific areas in need of immediate repair; and

WHEREAS, in order to address these fire damaged areas immediately to prevent further damage to Sheldon High School L Wing Building, and to lessen the risk of potential injury to students, District employees and visitors to the campus;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education of the Elk Grove Unified School District finds that:

1. The above recitals are true and correct;
2. The immediate need to rectify this emergency threat will not permit a delay that would result from competitive solicitation of bids for the removal and repair of the structurally damaged area; and
