Why ALICE?

- Lockdown in place and hide was the standard.
- Research of school shootings revealed that a new tactic was needed
- An options approach was developed that provides tools to increase chances of survival.

History of ALICE at PRJUSD

- ALICE was adopted by PRJUSD in 2017
- 2017-2018 Staff and some students received training.
- 2021 four additional staff were trained as instructors
- Jan-Feb 2022 all PRJUSD staff and students will be trained.

The First Line of Defense



- Depression
- Anxiety
- Anger



- Comments
- Social Media Posts
- Drawings

- If you hear, see, or read something, do not assume someone else will report it.
- Tell a school official or contact law enforcement immediately.
- Look out for your friends. Get them help.

ALICE

Awareness and Communication

- Alert
- Inform

Response Options

- Evacuate
- Lockdown
- Counter

Alert

- It involves recognizing signs of danger and receiving information about the danger from others.
- Many times people will freeze when encountering information regarding danger.

Lockdown

- If evacuation is not a safe option, move to the Lockdown.
- Barricade entry points of the classroom
- Prepare for next phase (counter and inform)


Inform

- Inform is getting information to law enforcement but also to provide information to others on campus to assist them to make decisions.

Counter

- Use all items available to distract the intruder.
- Noise, movement, thrown objects can be used.
- Use strength in numbers and element of surprise.
- Control the intruder

Decision Making Process



Evacuate

- The most preferred response
- There may be more than one route to evacuate
- Know the classroom and building well
- Once outside proceed to rally point
