Addendum to the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)
Between
Sonoma County Superintendent of School as the Local Educations Agency
For the North Coast Teacher Intern Program,
And Berkeley Unified School District
Signed Send and Dated April 8, 2021

This addendum outlines and provides the following:

1. In accordance with California Education Code Section 44320, each candidate must obtain fingerprint clearance prior to beginning their assignment. The fingerprinting process will be administered through the District. NCOSE will advise the candidates of their obligation to submit to fingerprinting and obtain clearance in advance of beginning their assignment.
2. In accordance with California Education Code Section 49406, each candidate prior to assignment to the District must obtain at the candidate's sole expense an examination by a licensed physician or qualified medical professional within the past 60 days to determine that they are free of active tuberculosis, prior to beginning their assignment in the District. NCSOE shall advise candidates of their obligation to provide at their own expense evidence of tuberculosis clearance by a medial professional to the District prior to their assignment start date.
3. Candidates must meet all COVID requirements outlined by the District.
