INSTRUCTION

Inter-High Student Council

Functions:

1. The Council shall coordinate interdistrict programs and activities involving high school students in the District, excluding inter- scholastic athletic events.
2. The student representative to the Board of Education has the responsibility of discussing District-wide student concerns identified by the Council with the Superintendent and the Board of Education.
3. The Council shall meet periodically with the Board of Education to discuss student problems and concerns.
4. The Inter-High Student Council representatives shall report on the activities of the Council to the Principals/designees and seek their advice and counsel.
5. The Council shall communicate matters of interest to the students of their respective high schools regarding the activities of the Council.
6. Subject to the approval of the Superintendent/designee, the Council shall develop by-laws governing its operations and procedures.

Organization:

1. The Inter-High Student Council shall consist of the following members:
 - A. The student member of the Board of Education

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B. Student Body Presidents/designee for each district high school, including the Alternative Education Center. (In the event of semester elections, the fall-term president shall serve for a full year along with the new spring-term president.)

2. The following students representing each comprehensive high school.

- • **a.** Senior Class President/designee
- • **b.** Junior Class President/designee
- • **c.** Sophomore Class President/designee
- • **d.** Freshman Class President/designee
- • **e.** ASB President/designee
- • **f.** **Two students from the general student body**
 - **i.** **If more than two students apply for the position from a school site, a random selection will determine which two students will serve on the Council.**

3. Two elected student representatives from the Alternative Education Center. (Elected representatives shall serve for one school year.)

4. The Principal/designee, of the same high school as the student member of the Board of Education will be responsible for supervising the Inter-High Council meetings and coordinating the Council's activities.
