POSTHUMOUS RECOGNITION OF MR. PAUL C. HANSEN

RESOLUTION NO. 21-22/44

Honoring the life and service of Mr. Paul C. Hansen

Whereas, Mr. Paul C. Hansen returned to his alma mater of Lynwood High School in 1973 to faithfully and honorably serve the Lynwood Unified School District for thirty-seven years as a Special Education Teacher and that service was unquestionably characterized by consistent commitment and outstanding loyalty to the staff and students of the community; and

Whereas, Mr. Hansen continued to serve the students of the Lynwood Unified School District as a Substitute Teacher and Stage Crew Advisor for an additional twelve years after retiring in 2010; and

Whereas, Mr. Hansen was solely responsible for maintaining records of various school wide events at Lynwood High School and was regularly seen at the top of the bleachers or at the back of the Performing Arts Center videotaping all school events; and

Whereas, Mr. Hansen dedicated countless hours to the students and staff at Lynwood High School as he trained students to run the stage crew and lights for school wide activities and recorded hundreds of hours of assemblies, concerts and athletic events; and

Whereas, Mr. Hansen served as the “unofficial” Lynwood High School Historian for 49 years from his graduation in 1968 until the day of his passing in 2022 and was a wealth of knowledge to administrators, staff, students and community members, cementing his legacy as “Once a Knight, Always a Knight”;

Now therefore be it hereby resolved, that we, the members of the Lynwood Unified School District Board of Education, express our sincerest appreciation for the dedication and service Mr. Hansen provided to Lynwood Unified School District, an accolade that is so richly earned and deserved.

Be it further resolved, that we extend our deepest condolences to the family of Mr. Paul C. Hansen, who passed away on February 8, 2022.

Be it finally resolved, that this resolution be made an integral part of the Minutes of the February 24, 2022, meeting of this Board.
