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Student Advisory Council - Purpose

- ▶ Provide input on District initiatives
- ▶ Give feedback on District priorities
- ▶ Improve communication and sharing of important and relevant information
- ▶ Increase student empowerment and stewardship of the work to ensure equitable access for all students across the District



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Student Advisory Council - 2021-2022

- ▶ Provide input on bond measure priorities
- ▶ Increase site awareness of mental health and social emotional support services/resources
- ▶ Give feedback to the Board of Education regarding student engagement
- ▶ Provide input on the selection of student school furniture/desks



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SAC - Feedback to the Board:

- ▶ *Why are students disengaged from school and school activities?*
 - ▶ Inconsistent attendance
 - ▶ Homework for many students takes most of the afternoon and evening.
 - ▶ Students are focusing on what is happening at home
 - ▶ COVID has taught students that plans are uncertain so they don't commit
- ▶ *What is causing students' lack of motivation to earn good grades?*
 - ▶ Workload is heavy
 - ▶ Grading systems



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SAC at School Sites

- ▶ Increase opportunity for student voice in school site initiatives and priorities:
 - ▶ *School Senate, Principal focus groups*
- ▶ Respond to information from the Fall Mental Health Survey



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Interhigh Council

- ▶ Student Representative to the Board
- ▶ Student Representative on the State Board
- ▶ Updated Board Policy
- ▶ Connecting student groups on campuses



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Next Steps

- ▶ Increase number of students involved at the District level
- ▶ Increase student engagement at the sites
- ▶ Increase student voice in the planning of SAC meetings
