Core Principles

1. Build a positive and cooperative process for bargaining and our overall relationship.
2. Support teaching and conditions for student learning.
3. Generate positive community support for CUSD.
4. Recruit, hire, retain and provide competitive wages and benefits for employees.
5. Maintain fiscal sustainability to support long-term, high-quality services.

Article 6: Compensation and Benefits

The District goal is to create a total compensation package (salaries and benefits) that supports employees while maintaining fiscal sustainability.

Article 7: Professional Day and Responsibility

The District goal is to revise contract language to reflect the changes to the student instructional day for the 2022-2023 school year, and to ensure educational equity across all grade levels.
