Dear Trustees,

Even though I assume that you had the best intentions, I was very disappointed to see that the majority of the Board voted for a plan that will negatively impact the school with the most Latino students based on the emotional cries of a group of parents. This board ran on the criticism of the financial mistakes of the last Board, and yet the majority of you voted for the least financially responsible option.

Several times I have heard Board Members express concern over the OCR complaint, but a similar complaint could (and should) be made for the way the Latino community around Georgia Brown has been treated. For years, students have been left in a school full of cockroaches, fleas, leaking roofs, inadequate bathrooms, and a deteriorated playground. Now they will be moved to a campus that will still have inadequate space and will be unsafe due to surrounding traffic concerns.

I am certain that when 2 years have gone by, and it is time for the Speck students to move to the 36<sup>th</sup> Street campus, they will not go willingly. Once again, you will have angry parents who will refuse to move. If the board gives in to their emotion cry again, you will be moving Georgia Brown students back to a campus that is woefully too small, and there won't be any money left to build adequately.

Our tax payers need answers to the following questions: What is the cost of additional construction on the temporary campus to accommodate Georgia Brown? How much more will it cost for Speck to make a double move? Has the Measure M Oversight Committee been asked to respond to this decision? Is the city aware that nearly 1400 students are going to be dropped off and picked up daily in one block despite one board member's flippant comment that "parents will have to figure out carpooling?" How much will it cost the district to provide adequate parking for staff and parents? The kinder play area is too small for 2 classes now, so what will it cost the district to construct a larger play area for 4 kinder classes? The new building with 10 classrooms will be used entirely for classes, so how much will it cost to enlarge or build a cafeteria? What other Measure M projects will have to be suspended due to the extra costs required by this option?

While it is easy for the board members to raise their hands and pass a motion, it is now left up to the principals, teachers, and parents to find solutions to an impossible situation. Please reconsider your decision and do what is best for all our students.

To the Paso Robles school board,

My name is Miriam Gonzalez, I am a member of the school site council, DELAC and ELAC committees and a parent of Georgia Brown student.

I am writing to express my disappointment in the decision that was made by this School Board regarding the relocation of Georgia Brown to the temporary campus and the various moves of the Glenn speck students. It seems that the board keeps making decisions that continue to cause emotional distress to our children and to us as parents. Moving Georgia Brown to the temporary campus will require upgrades in order to fit all of the students currently attending Georgia Brown, or is the Board going to downsize the program? And if that is the case, will my child continue to attend Georgia Brown? From what I've been hearing, there is a lack of sufficient funds to upgrade our current site to the capacity of the program as it is now. Leaving the Glenn speck students in the temporary campus for another 2 years allows us to have those funds available as well as avoid relocation costs and emotional distress to the kids who keep moving around.

I realize that there were promises made to those students at the Glenn speck site but we have also been made promises that were never kept. Our children have been underserved and neglected for at least the past 19 years since I have been an active member of the Georgia Brown site. Our children have not had adequate learning facilities and the playground is neither adequate nor safe. It is time for the School Board to start making decisions based on what is best for the greatest number of students and our community, and to make those decisions taking into consideration the finances available to do the job right.

My name is Brian Dorfman and I have been a healthcare provider for over 30 years. I'm an expert in anatomy and physiology and have done extensive research in this field at UCLA. The childhood mental health crisis is evident in high rates of anxiety, depression, suicide and stress among our children today. From a physiology perspective, this is but one of the long-term effects of decreasing oxygen and increasing carbon dioxide in the breathing process for many hours a day for months on end. There are no long-term studies on this respiratory-induced stress with children, but the established research is clear: When we decrease oxygen and increase CO<sub>2</sub>, the "fight or flight" response is stimulated. This is an automatic response, that over time, becomes the norm. I'll just have anxiety, depression and stress. Because I do want to breath. This is a long-term physiological effect of masking.

The anatomical effect of inhibiting respiration is a reduction of movement in the breathing mechanism which directly decreases the flow of vital nutrients to the brain and inhibits the removal of waste products. Among these vital nutrients is glucose, which is the source of food for the brain. In the time of chronic masking, however, glucose is redirected to the muscles because the body is fighting to get oxygen and thinks it needs to run from the tiger. Once you understand the complexity of the breathing mechanism, and how deeply it is tied into the health and wellness of the whole human system, you will understand that current school policies are harming children. According the CDC, since the start of the pandemic, youth suicide attempts have spiked by over 20%, and among girls 12-17, we witnessed a 50% increase in hospitalization from attempted suicide. This is completely unacceptable. Adults must remember that these are fragile systems we are manipulating. A child's development is much more complicated, sensitive and accelerated than that of adults. The cumulative, detrimental effects of masking are real and are resulting in a childhood mental health crisis the likes of which we have not

seen before. Please do everything in your power to protect the health and well-being of all students by fighting to remove the mask mandates TODAY. Tomorrow is too late.

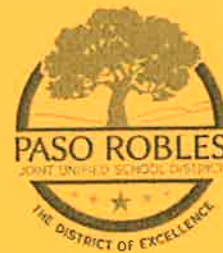
Dear School Board,

I hope I'm contacting the right person to have this email considered at today's board meeting. If so, I'd like to remain anonymous if at all possible.

As a student at PRHS, I have always valued the faculty's focus on our safety. Since the beginning of the pandemic, I have been grateful for the measures taken to protect our schools health and well-being. That said, I'm fully aware that not all students feel the same about the rules regarding mask wearing.

Since the beginning of this school year, everything has been a little more relaxed than before. Outdoor socializing and extracurriculars have been so wonderful to have back. I've been grateful for the masks indoors, though, because being in close quarters with people for extended periods of time is a genuine risk to our health.

Personally, I fear for my own safety and that of my friends should the indoor mandate be lifted. We are a school with a wide diversity of opinion and life experience, but as enriching as that can be socially, it means that I cannot know if my classmates are being cautious and safe in regards to COVID-19 (vaccination status, mask wearing habit).

I absolutely would not like to speak ill of anyone who chooses not to wear a mask around strangers. I understand everyone should have a right to lead their lives how they please. Yet in a public school, I feel that students should be required to protect their peers. Many have argued that they should choose to protect themselves from COVID, but masks are not just meant to protect ourselves, they are to protect others.

I understand that we cannot change the lifestyle of students at our school, but I feel the board is responsible to keep school a place safe for all students, where we can feel safe regarding our physical well-being.

Assuming mask wearing does not physically harm a student, truly cannot imagine why they ought not to be wearing a mask. What I've been trying to figure out is what problem people have with them in the first place. To the average student, a mask should be a minor inconvenience at most. I've heard people complain of general student morale, but I hardly find that as important as the health of students.

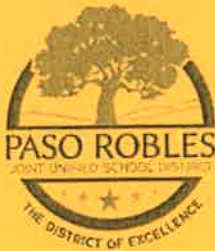

I am sending this in to be read at the board meeting tonight. My name is Gabby Bodenshot and it is for item 6 on the agenda.

Good evening school board members. Thank you for having us here tonight. My name is Gabby Bodenshot and I am a sophomore at Paso Robles high school. I am here with my peers, and I am here to elucidate the matter of pro choice masking in our schools.

As it is widely known, the state of California, has lifted the indoor mask mandate as of February 16th. Penny Borenstein, the health director from The Slo County health department released a new issue on February 15th at 1:40pm. Borenstein states that, "The State order requires masking in indoor public places for those who are not vaccinated and for everyone, regardless of vaccination status, in healthcare facilities, schools, childcare, etc..." (2). The difference between a public mandate and a law is that a mandate, or order, is interchangeable. Meaning this can be set or lifted at any given time.

Recently in California there have been student run protests against the enforcement of wearing of masks indoors to receive an in person education. After a large protest of about 800 Students from Oak Ridge high school, The El Dorado school district in California is no longer enforcing the mask mandate for high school students. The district announced that "The enforcement of masking will be done by educating students and asking them to mask, but no further action of exclusion from class will be taken." (Sullivan, 3). The district told the parents it was "in the middle of a very difficult and progressively escalating situation to comply with the State and California Department of Public Health mandates and our actual ability to enforce those mandates." (4). As we see the difference in opinions in our district as well, it is apparent that this can be an option for our schooling and students.

The El Dorado district stated "there will not be a significant change in student mask enforcement." (12). "We will continue to do our best to comply with the mandate. Our school liability carriers all warn us that if we take explicit action to defy State guidance we will be held liable and accountable for any such decision and in a very litigious society we have no legal protection." (13).



Roseville Joint Union district also changed their mask enforcement policy, enacting an optional masking policy. A resolution passed by the district's board of trustees opted to make masking the choice of parents and students, which then the liability would rather fall on the person's choice of to mask or to not mask. The district also announced, "We have been legally advised that the California Department of Public Health does not require that individuals, such as teachers or school staff, enforce the mandate and therefore, cannot be held liable." (15). With this being said, it is possible to give us a safe, in person education, while having the choice of masking. It is our right to receive an in person education, which should not force students who would rather not wear a mask in the classroom to have to choose an alternative education. Since the return of in person learning in our state in 2021, independent study has been the alternate option for students who choose not to wear a mask. However, it is illegal for a school district to force students into an independent study program. It is only up to the parents and students to decide their own type of education. With this being said, we respectfully ask to follow the examples proven already in our state, and to give the parents and students in the Paso Robles Joint Unified school district the choice to wear a mask while receiving their right to an education. Thank you.

To whom it may concern,

My name is Gavin Blythe and I am a Sophomore at Paso Robles High School. I am on both the Water Polo and Swim teams for Paso Robles High. The building of this pool is necessary for us to have fair, competitive aquatic seasons. The current pool is hurting us for not only High School competitions, but also for college opportunities.

The Municipal pool is outdated and in constant need of repairs. Just last week, our aquatics team missed five practices due to a broken pool pump. The only reason we did not miss a 6th is because we were able to practice at Kennedy Club Fitness. At times we are unable to use the deep end during evening practices because some of the lights are out, and it is a safety hazard. There have been other instances where we are unable to use the pool due to mechanical issues.

For Water Polo practice, we are unable to tread water in the shallow end. We instead must squat down, and avoid using the ground as much as possible. For games, it is illegal to touch the bottom of the pool. This puts us at an extreme disadvantage as when we travel to schools that have pools that meet regulations, our bodies are not conditioned to treading water the entire game as required. The few times we have games at the Municipal pool, there are constant turnovers due to players (on both teams) accidentally touching the bottom because of the shallow depth.

We are unable to have home Swim meets as our pool does not meet regulations.

It is difficult, and for some students it is impossible, to get to and from practices because the pool is not on school campus. In addition, having a pool on campus would greatly benefit the aquatics athletes as would no longer be a struggle to get rides to practices after school, and would allow more time for student athletes to focus on school, rather than spending time traveling to/from the pool and school, and to meets away from home. It will also be a lot easier for morning practices in regards to requiring a bus to travel from the pool to school.

Having the pool on campus will also introduce the opportunity for water safety classes to all students not only at the high school, but surrounding campuses as well. In the United
