GOALS

85% of students will increase their growth percentiles by 5 percentage points on external/formal assessments by June 2022-2023.

**Will analyze NWEA data to create a plan to address the academic slide due to the pandemic / Distance Learning*

Decrease the percentage of chronically absent students from 77% to 60% by June of 2022-2023.

Liberty High School: 2022-23 Goals

Academic Testing (WASC Goal#1):

85% of students will increase their growth percentiles by 5 percentage points on external/formal assessments by June 2022-2023. Our Winter NWEA MAP data indicated Seniors increased their growth percentiles by 22% in Reading.

Plan of Action: We are implementing Imagine Math to support academic recovery. We will continue to analyze the 2021-2022 CAASPP data and/or the NWEA Map to further develop our academic recovery plan for the 2022-2023 school year.

Climate & Culture (WASC Goal #2):

Improve ***Sense of Belonging*** from 64 to 80 using the Additional Measures subsets of REACH student survey by April 2022. The REACH survey will be administered in April 2023.

Plan of Action: We will analyze our student surveys and feedback data to tease out the pertinent information. We will utilize our advisory and mental health resources to support our students and build back our school community.

Climate & Culture (WASC Goal #3 & Critical Area Focus #2) :

Improve student's positive view of their future possible selves, set and work towards goals, and their belief that they can influence what happens in their lives from 71 to 75 score using the Aspirations category of the REACH survey. The REACH survey will be administered in April 2022.

Plan of Action: We will analyze our student surveys and feedback data to tease out the pertinent information. We acknowledge that our external LTI program was dampened and more emphasis on internal exploration was needed.

Student Engagement (WASC Goal #4):

Decrease the percentage of chronically absent students from 77% to 60% by June of 2023. Coming back to in-person learning, LHS has maintained an overall attendance average of 78% with our Junior class with the highest percentage of 83%

Strategies implemented during the 2021-2022 school year and these will be continued during the 2022-23 school year:

- SART protocols and interventions
- Individual learning plans designed with student's needs and interests
- Weekly calls and check ins
- Intentional community building activities
- Linking students to our mentor program

Additional Initiatives:

- Develop a substantive Wellness Center that will provide early interventions for students experiencing social-emotional or mental health challenges that may not only affect learning in the classroom, but their overall well-being. **WASC Goal #4**
- Re-examine our LTI program to define full inclusion and develop a plan for relaunch for the 2022-2023 school year. **WASC Goal #5**
- Continue to use the lens of equity (Who is this benefitting?; Where are the barriers?) to develop all programs at LHS. **LCAP Goal #4**
- Renewal of the California Model Continuation School status for 2022-2023 school year **Critical Area #1**
