

INITIAL DATA LIST

District staff creates master spreadsheet of all current Kinder through 7th grade students: demographics, special education, 504, language, SES, local assessment data

2

ORDERING CRITERIA

Students are sorted by grade level using ELPAC scores, SES status, SPED and 504 identification, reading and math data

3

STAFFING

Preliminary classes are built based on the number of employees working summer school and their grade level experience

4

STAFF INPUT

Sites prioritize or recommend additional students. Ed Services and SPED identify students not eligible for ESY

5

STUDENT INVITATIONS

District staff individually call families to invite their children to summer school and to complete summer school enrollment form until all spaces are filled
