8.1. Escalon High School Board Representative

Minutes:

8.3. Period 9 Attendance

Minutes:

Superintendent Costa reported the district ADA is 94.64%, which is 3.46% down from prior year's period 9. The district's current year to date ADA is 93.41%. Escalon Charter Academy is leading both period 9 and year to date with averages over 98%. Vista High School and Escalon Charter Academy were the only schools with ADA higher than last year.

10. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Minutes:

Superintendent Costa reported Assistant Superintendent Ricardo Chavez, Director of Technology Luke Childs, and Principal of Escalon High School Eric Simoni will begin recruiting for an I.T. intern from Escalon High. The two year program will start the 2022-23 school year.

Site visits took place last week, and will continue next week. He stated schools are definitely working their way back to pre-COVID status.

The district determined the architect did not include new windows in the restroom modernization at Van Allen. The board will see a change order at a future board meeting.

The district recently met with the architect and coaches to discuss the track modernization. The goal is to have designs approved and select a contractor by February 2023, and have project completed by August 2023.

10.1. Financial Report - February / March 2022

Minutes:

Superintendent Costa reported the district received \$24.3 million for fund 1 through March 1, 2022, which is 58% of the budgeted revenues. The district has expended \$25.5, which is 55% of the budgeted expenditures.
