It is Recommended that the Board of Trustees Accept for First Reading Updates to Selected Board Policies and / or Administrative Regulations and Bylaw.

**BACKGROUND:** Per California Education Code and with the Board's desire to have updated and current policies, staff prepare policies to be reviewed and approved by the Board annually.

**DESCRIPTION DETAILS:** The following revised Board Policy/Administrative Regulation is presented to the Board of Trustees for first reading. This BP/AR has been revised based on samples provided by the California School Boards Association (CSBA) and reflect recent changes to the law and/or court decisions.

**BP/AR 3513.3 - Tobacco-Free Schools**  
(BP/AR revised)

Policy updated to reflect **NEW LAW** (ABX2 9, 2016) which requires all districts, not just those receiving state Tobacco-Use Prevention Education funds, to prohibit tobacco use on school campuses. Policy also reflects new definitions of "smoking" and "tobacco" pursuant to **NEW LAW** (SBX2 5, 2016). Regulation reflects provision of ABX2 9 which requires signs prohibiting tobacco use to be displayed at all school entrances, and deletes option to designate a smoking area on campus.
