

# SEAL Summer Bridge 2016

Summer Bridge is an intensive professional development opportunity for teachers who have completed a year of SEAL professional development. The 10 days of cross grade level co-teaching allows teachers to try new strategies and build articulation and alignment across grades while observing and supporting each other to build a shared understanding of SEAL's approach. While Summer Bridge does serve as an academic enrichment for students, it is primarily designed to serve as high quality professional development for teachers.
