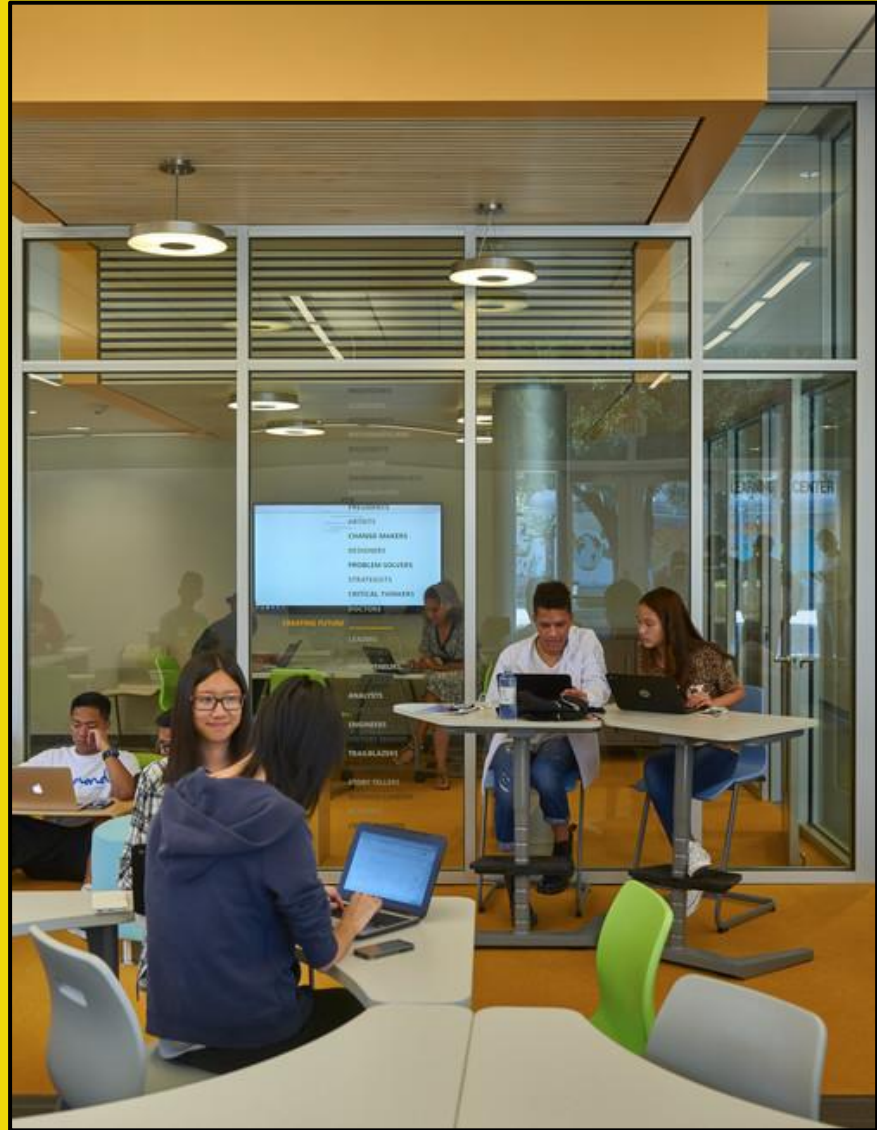

7th Grade = 70 students

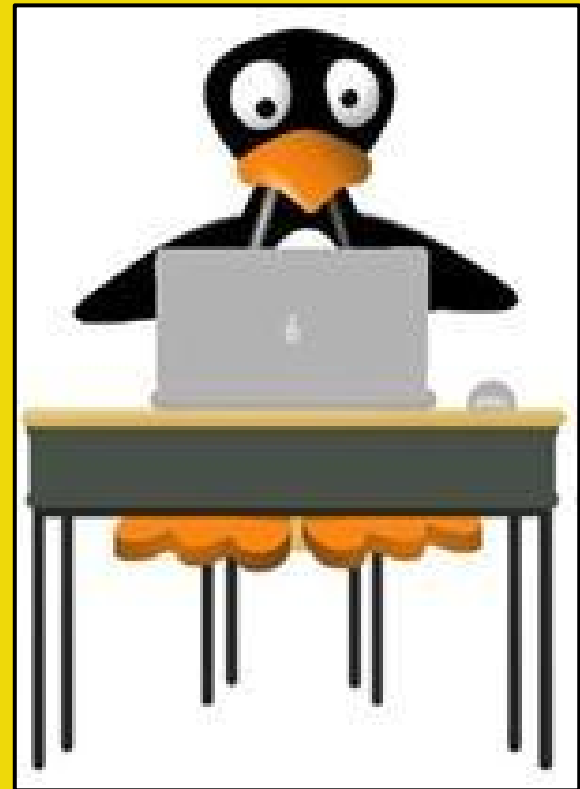
