



PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, The City of Milpitas has designated three acres of land located at South Milpitas Boulevard and Garden Street as parkland; and

WHEREAS, the park shall be named the Bob McGuire Park for which a ribbon cutting ceremony is designated for October 1, 2016; and

WHEREAS, Bob McGuire was the first Director of Parks and Recreation for Milpitas (1964-1980) and initially was hired in this position jointly by the Milpitas Unified School District and City of Milpitas to create a parks and recreation program that would serve the community with a special focus on youth; and

WHEREAS, Bob McGuire developed dynamic after school programs such as “After the Bell” and “Almost Anything Goes” including a day camp at Ed Levin park for summer adventures, as well as the Milpitas Junior Olympics; and

WHEREAS, Bob McGuire was later elected Milpitas Director for Open Space Authority for two terms, and was one of the founding members and lifelong supporter of the Milpitas Historical Society; and

WHEREAS, Parks and open spaces add tremendous value to the quality of the educational environment for students in the Milpitas Unified School District students; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Governing Board of the Milpitas Unified School District recognizes the City of Milpitas for its dedication to improving the lives of our community members.
