Approval of Media Repository RFP Process

WHEREAS, the Irvine Unified School District ("District") wishes to procure a comprehensive media repository to support teaching and learning; and

WHEREAS, Media Repositories are of a specialized and unique nature; and

WHEREAS, increased integration of technology and digital content in IUSD courses is driving a need for a repository to house media; and

WHEREAS, there has been a proliferation of services and products developed to serve this need; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Public Contract Code section 20118.2, school districts are allowed to acquire technology solutions and services through a Request for Proposal ("RFP") process that takes into account system capabilities and other factors in addition to cost; and

WHEREAS, the District wishes to publish and RFP for the acquisition of a Media Repository and related services, including the following evaluation components: (1) Price 20%; (2) Functionality and Usability 50%; (3) Vendor Support and Ability to Perform 20%; (4) Technical Requirements 10%.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE IRVINE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, ORDER, AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The District's proposed procurement of Media Repository and related services qualifies as procurement under Public Contract Code section 20118.2 and is hereby authorized by the Board.
- 2. The evaluation factors and the percentages assigned to each factor are hereby authorized and approved.
- 4. The award of the RFP and authorization for the Assistant Superintendent of Business Services to enter into a contract between the District and selected provider shall be taken by separate Board action.
