RESOLUTION No. 14-15-41**

Approval of Media Repository RFP Process

WHEREAS, the Irvine Unified School District ("District") wishes to procure a comprehensive media repository to support teaching and learning; and

WHEREAS, Media Repositories are of a specialized and unique nature; and

WHEREAS, increased integration of technology and digital content in IUSD courses is driving a need for a repository to house media; and

WHEREAS, there has been a proliferation of services and products developed to serve this need; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Public Contract Code section 20118.2, school districts are allowed to acquire technology solutions and services through a Request for Proposal ("RFP") process that takes into account system capabilities and other factors in addition to cost; and

WHEREAS, the District wishes to publish and RFP for the acquisition of a Media Repository and related services, including the following evaluation components: (1) Price 20%; (2) Functionality and Usability 50%; (3) Vendor Support and Ability to Perform 20%; (4) Technical Requirements 10%.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE IRVINE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, ORDER, AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:

1. The District's proposed procurement of Media Repository and related services qualifies as procurement under Public Contract Code section 20118.2 and is hereby authorized by the Board.

2. The evaluation factors and the percentages assigned to each factor are hereby authorized and approved.

4. The award of the RFP and authorization for the Assistant Superintendent of Business Services to enter into a contract between the District and selected provider shall be taken by separate Board action.
