STAFF COMMENT SHEET

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Governing Board award the bid for the Classroom Linear Fluorescent Lighting Retrofit Project to Blue Streak Lighting Services for Forest Hill Elementary School and Sherman Oaks Elementary School with the total low bid of \$218,270 and reject all other bids received.

BACKGROUND:

The District will be rewiring and replacing the existing linear fluorescent light bulbs with LED retrofit kits for improved energy efficiency and lower utility costs. Only Blue Streak’s bid for Forest Hill and Sherman Oaks schools came under budget. Is it therefore recommended that the Board accept Blue Streak’s bid and reject all other bids received.
