Visit Details

- A team of four people came to CUSD from Jan. 24-27
- They spent one day at Blackford and one day at Sherman Oaks
- They held interviews with District Office staff, English Language Advisory Committee (ELAC), School Site Council members, and Educational Associates providing services to struggling students
- They walked the schools with Administration and looked specifically at English Language Development time and then general core instruction
- We had entry and exit meetings daily where they described the process and gave us feedback on possible findings at the end of the day

Positive Feedback

- They really enjoyed the chance to visit a Dual Immersion program and were impressed by the Spanish being spoken by non-native speakers
- They loved the after school STEAM class for English Language Learners at S.Oaks
- They were very impressed with the quality of ELD instruction at Blackford
- They were impressed with how the teachers demonstrated their commitment to learning by continuing their teaching without missing a beat when the visitors entered the room
