Resolution Authorizing Certain Certificated Staff to Teach in a Departmentalized Setting

WHEREAS, District Board Policy No. 4113 provides that the Superintendent or his designee may assign a teacher, with his/her consent, to a position outside his/her credential authorization when specifically authorized by law or regulation; and

WHEREAS, Education Code section 44258.3 allows the Governing Board by resolution to authorize the holder of a credential, other than an emergency permit, to teach any subjects in departmentalized classes in kindergarten or any of grade 1 to 12, inclusive, provided the Governing Board verifies, prior to making the assignment, that the teacher has adequate knowledge of each subject to be taught and the teacher consents to the assignment; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Board has adopted Administrative Regulation 4113 which sets forth the policies and procedures for verifying the adequacy of subject knowledge on the part of the teachers assigned to departmentalized classes; and

WHEREAS, the teaching assignments made pursuant to this resolution are only valid for one year and are only valid in San Rafael City Schools.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Governing Board authorizes the following teacher to teach in a single subject class for the 2014-2015 school year with his/her consent, according to the provisions of Education Code section 44258.3, as follows:
