- 17,600 less teachers in the CA workforce than 2007
- Shortages in ALL subject areas
- 15,582 open teaching positions in California
- MUSD Openings for 17-18
 - 17 Special Ed. including psychologists and SLPs
 - 6 Multiple Subject
 - 2 BCLAD for Dual Immersion
 - 1 Science Specialist
 - 10 Secondary
