



Curriculum Policy Council (CPC) Ballot Results

On April 20, 2017 the Curriculum Policy Council (CPC) voted for the following items. There were twenty-eight (28) signatures on the sign-in sheet; twenty-four (24) were CPC members who have full rights of a single vote. After further review of the CPC bylaws, it was determined that a quorum was met and no further votes were required.
