Dear Mr. Winthrop:

- The **Milpitas USD requests continued funding for Milpitas High School, Engineering and Technology Academy ID # 0431**, a California Partnership Academy (CPA), for the **2017–18 school year**. We recognize that funding is contingent on the inclusion of CPA funds in the approved state budget.

For the **2017–18** school year, based on the current funding level, the **projected enrollment** of students in the academy is **164**. We understand that the maximum funding amount may be reduced based on the number of students enrolled or the number of fundable students is less than specified in California *Education Code (EC)* Section 54691.

As a requirement of funding, the district agrees to follow the CPA model as defined in *EC* sections 54690 through 54699. Assurances are listed on pages 2 through 3.

- The Milpitas USD requests to **discontinue funding for Milpitas High School, Engineering and Technology Academy ID # 0431**, a CPA, for the **2017–18 school year**. I look forward to hearing from CDE staff for the next steps.


