



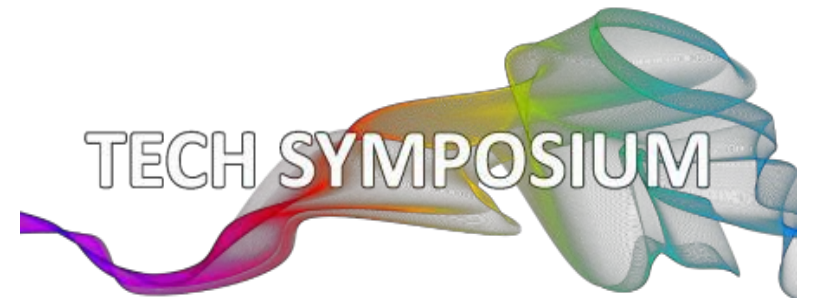

- ▶ 150 participants, including several guests
- ▶ Less than \$30 per person for breakfast, lunch, materials and a swag bag
