HOMEWORK/MAKEUP WORK

School-Site Homework Plan

The principal and staff at each school shall develop and regularly review a school-site homework plan—which includes, aligned with Board Policy 6154, that is articulated throughout the district between sites and grade levels. The plan will include guidelines for the assignment of homework, and describes also describe the responsibilities of and timelines for students, staff and parents/guardians. The plan shall identify all of the following:

- 1. For each grade level, the The amount of time that students shall be expected to spend on homework for each grade level and/or content area.
- 2. For each grade level, the The extent to which homework assignments shall systematically involve participation by parents/guardians for each grade level and or content area.
- 3. The means by which parents/guardians shall <u>regularly</u> be informed about:
 - a. Homework expectations and due dates
 - b. How homework relates to the student's grades
 - c. How best to help their children students
 - d. When excessive or critical assignments have been missed
- 4. Techniques that will be taught to help students allocate their time wisely, meet their deadlines, and develop good personal study habits.
- 5. The access that students shall have to obtain:
 - a. Resource materials from the library media center
 - b. Any available assistance and/or tutoring after both during and outside of school hours.
- 6. The means by which teachers shall coordinate assignments so that students do not receive an overloadhave a balance of homework one day and very little the next assignments.
- 7. For each grade level, the The extent to which homework assignments shall emphasize independent research, reports, special reading and problem-solving activities for each grade level or content area.

Makeup Work

The Superintendent or designee shall notify parents/guardians that no student may have his/her

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grade reduced or lose academic credit for any excused absence when missed assignments and tests are satisfactorily completed within a reasonable period of time. Such notification shall include the full text of Education Code 48205. (Education Code 48980)
